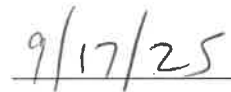

4. A motion was made to approve the base station license application recommendations.

Item 5 on the Agenda, proposing rules to increase minimum per-mile pay rates for high-volume for-hire vehicle drivers to account for increased driver expenses, change the way utilization rates are calculated and applied, prevent high-volume companies from manipulating driver availability, and collect additional data related to driver availability.
The rule was presented for a vote, and the rule passed by a unanimous vote.
