**FOR-HIRE STREET HAILS AND TAXI GROUP RIDES TO BE
DISCONTINUED AS OF 11:59 PM, NOVEMBER 5 DUE TO
SUBSTANTIAL RESTORATION OF MTA SERVICE**

The New York City Taxi and Limousine Commission (TLC) announces that, due to the substantial restoration of citywide MTA bus and subway service, the emergency measures implemented to assist people during the storm emergency, including the authorization of for-hire vehicles to accept street hails and taxicabs to accept multiple passengers, is to be discontinued as of 11:59 PM on Monday, November 5, 2012. This notice rescinds Industry Notice #12-37.

All medallion taxicab service must be provided via the normal metered fare system, as provided for in the TLC's rules and regulations. All livery, black car, limousine and commuter van service must be provided via pre-arrangement as provided for in the TLC's rules and regulations.
