NOTICE: ALTERNATIVE FUEL MEDALLIONS SELECTED IN THE MAY 15 ACCESSIBILITY DRAWING

Pursuant to TLC rule 35 RCNY Chapter 58, Section 58-50 (Accessible Vehicle Conversion), the first Alternative Fuel Medallion yellow taxi accessibility drawing was held on May 15, 2024, at TLC headquarters. The following 21 medallions were selected:

7T12	7T23	7T28	7T33	7T39	9T23	9T31
9T36	9T39	9T44	9T48	9T59	9T60	9T61
9T65	9T72	9T75	9T79	9T90	9T96	9T98

The selected medallions must place an alternative fuel, wheelchair accessible vehicle into service once their current vehicle is retired, or if the vehicle is changed for any other reason. Approved vehicles are listed here.

The medallions <u>NOT</u> selected in the drawing are <u>NOT</u> required to place an alternative fuel, accessible vehicle into service when their current vehicle is retired. However, each medallion's accessibility requirement will alternate during each subsequent retirement cycle. For example, those medallions not selected in this drawing will be required to hack up an approved alternative fuel, accessible vehicle in the next (subsequent) retirement cycle.

All owners whose medallions were entered into the drawing will receive a letter from the TLC detailing the results of the drawing and next steps.
