1. The Chair called the meeting to order and reported the following:

- The Chair reported that the Garden in Transit project would take place from September to December 2007. (Tr. pp. 3-5)

- The Chair reported that the taxicab technology customer enhancements were in the functional testing stage, and that in the next few months the TLC would be conducting related outreach and rulemaking. (Tr. pp.6-9)
- The Chair reported that Commission staff had conducted a survey of FHV drivers and that the results of the analysis would be presented to the Commissioners. (Tr. p.9)
- The Chair reported recent additions to the Commission staff: 16 inspectors, Deputy Commissioner for Licensing Gary Weiss, Assistant Commissioner for

- 11. Commissioner Dear made a motion to accept the proposal to allow half-partitions as an option for taxicabs. Commissioner Giannoulis seconded the motion, and it passed unanimously. (Tr. p.101).
- 12. Commissioner Arout made a motion to adjourn the meeting. Commissioner Giannoulis seconded the motion, and it passed unanimously. (Tr. p. 102)
