- Be able to communicate efficiently via phone and email as necessary.
- Data entry for sessions as needed.
- Provide technical, data and statistical support for the unit.
- Access to a computer with video capability, a headset, and a Chrome web browser in which DVS will provide.
- Compliance to the all rules and regulations of the City of New York and NYC Department of Veterans' Services.
- Be able to problem solve.
