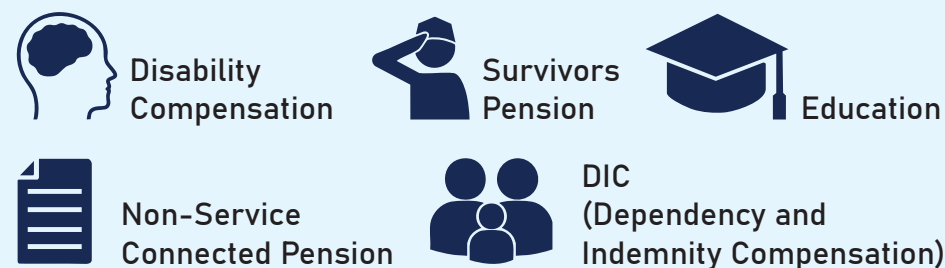


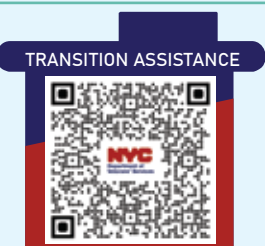

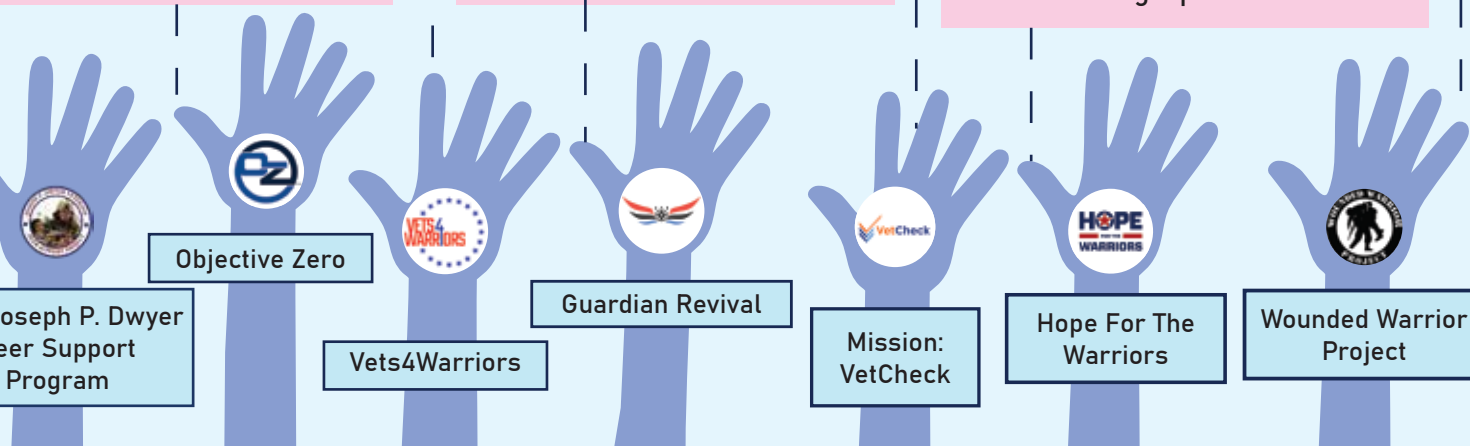
Receive free 24/7 help from a confidential peer support network through private chats, emails, phone calls, and text conversations.
