

**A RESOLUTION OF THE
NEW YORK CITY WORKFORCE DEVELOPMENT BOARD
APPROVING A PROGRAM YEAR 2021 FUNDING TRANSFER FROM
ADMINISTRATIVE TO YOUTH PROGRAM FUNDS**

WHEREAS, the Workforce Innovation and Opportunity Act Section 128(b)(4), grants local Workforce Development Boards (LWDB) the ability to use up to 10 percent of WIOA Youth funding for Administrative costs;

WHEREAS, Workforce Development System Technical Advisory #17-6, issued by the New York State Department of Labor on June 15, 2017, enables local Boards to transfer up to 100% of Administrative funding to Program funding;

WHEREAS, funding transfers allow local Workforce Development Boards to most effectively serve their jobseeker and employer customers;

WHEREAS, the New York City Workforce Development Board seeks to transfer Program Year 2021 funds from Administrative funding to Youth program funding;

WHEREAS, the proposed transfer would increase the Program Year 2021 WIOA Youth Program budget from \$20.4 million to \$21.9 million;

WHEREAS, Governor Hochul signed [legislation](#) on September 2, 2021, to extend virtual access to public meetings under New York State's Open Meetings Law through January 15, 2022;

WHEREAS, the New York City Workforce Development Board convened a virtual meeting on December 14, 2021, in accordance with the state Open Meetings Law;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, the Board hereby approves the transfer of \$1,473,772 in Program Year 2021 funds from Administrative funding to Youth program funding.

This resolution shall take effect immediately.
