

March 19th – Final Deadline to Apply for NYC Teaching Fellows

The NYC Teaching Fellows is an alternative teacher certification program that helps you become a full-time teacher. Work in NYC Public Schools while getting all your requirements to earn your initial teaching certification in New York State. Get seven weeks of extensive hands-on training experience in a classroom setting before teaching full-time. You will also get your master's degree in education, with financial help from the program. The NYC Teaching Fellows timeline is as follows:

- Training begins in June and concludes in early August.
- After training, you will be eligible to begin working as a full-time NYC Public Schools teacher in September.

Current training is offered for Unarmed Security Guard positions. Additional qualifications are as follows:

- 18 Years old or over with a GED or High School Diploma
- Must be actively looking for employment and willing to report job placement upon course completion
- Bring a valid ID
