Dedicated Bus Lanes

B46 buses now have their own **dedicated lane**, moving passengers **faster** while making the street more predictable for drivers.



Bus Priority at Lights

B46 SBS buses are equipped with transit signal priority (TSP) technology which communicates with traffic signals so the bus spends less time waiting at traffic lights.

Coming Spring 2016



Faster Fare Payment

With off-board fare payment, riders will pay their fare **before boarding the bus** with a MetroCard or coins and board through any door, greatly reducing the time waiting to pay at the front of the bus.



Real-Time Information

Bus Time displays and neighborhood maps are coming to most B46 SBS stops, so riders will know when the next SBS or Local bus is coming in real time.

Bus Bulbs (Curb Extensions)

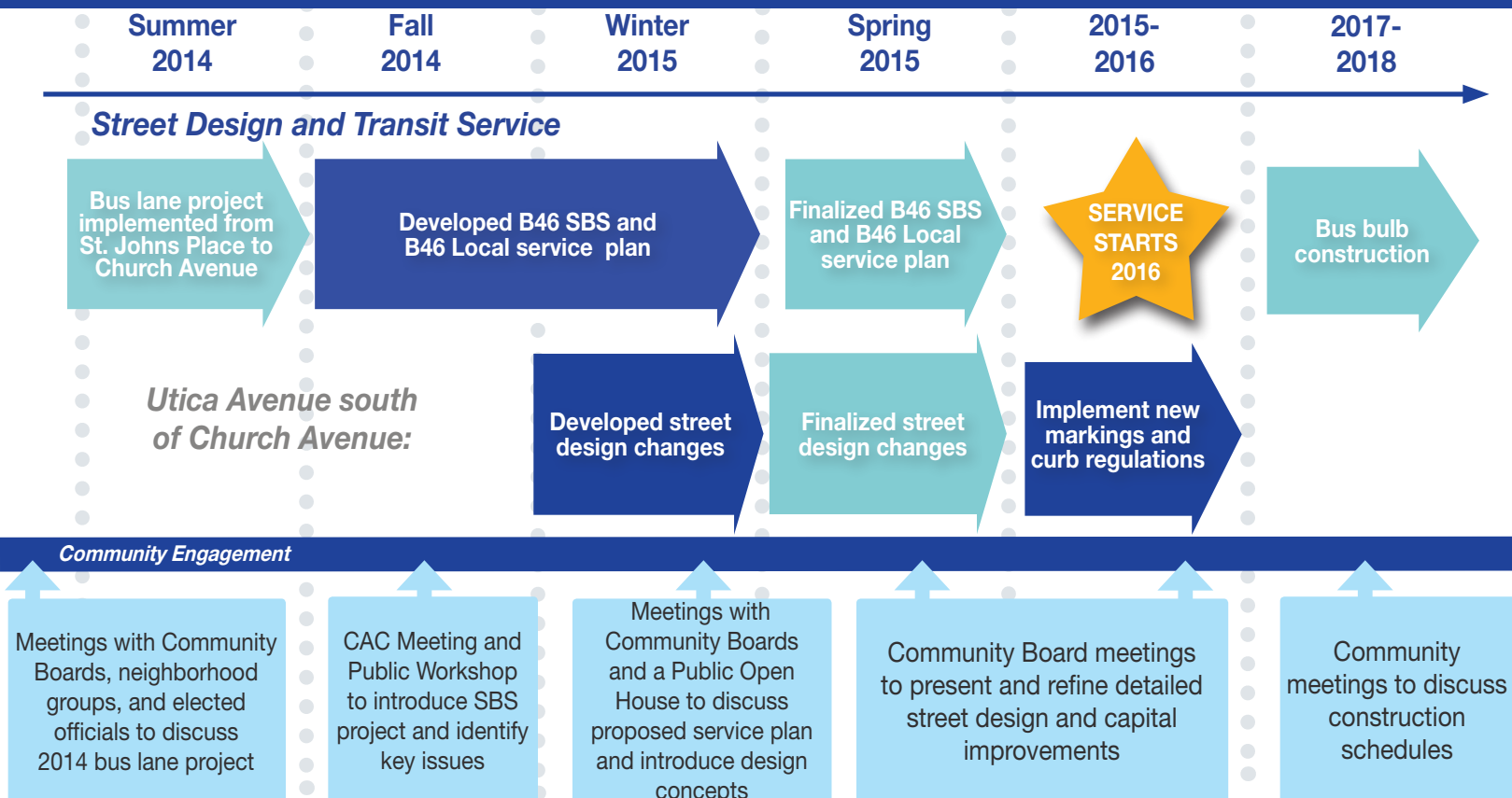
By extending the sidewalk into the street to meet the bus, riders have more room to wait and board safely and comfortably.

How Does Off-Board Fare Payment Work?

B46 SBS riders **must** dip their MetroCards or use coins to get a ticket to ride **before** boarding the bus. The cost is the same as a Limited bus, Local bus or the subway. Transfers are stored on the MetroCard. If paying by coins, show the ticket to the bus operator to get a paper transfer MetroCard. Riders then board the bus at any door, greatly reducing wait times at bus stops.

PLANNED B46 ROUTE AND BUS STOPS

The B46 Local will be extended to Williamsburg Bridge Plaza, making all stops along Broadway 24 hours per day

The B46 Local will continue to make all local stops from DeKalb Av to Kings Plaza

The B46 SBS will make all SBS stops from DeKalb Av to Kings Plaza

The B46 SBS will not make local stops south of Avenue H
