# NOTICE OF EXAMINATION

**PROMOTION TO RECREATION SUPERVISOR**  
**Exam No. 0519**

**WHEN TO APPLY:** From: **March 3, 2010**      **APPLICATION FEE: \$45.00**  
 To: **March 23, 2010**      Payable by mail by money order to DCAS (EXAMS),  
 or payable online by credit card, bank card, or debit card.

**THE TEST DATE:** The multiple-choice test is expected to be held on **Saturday, June 19, 2010.**

**WHAT THE JOB INVOLVES:** Recreation Supervisors, under general supervision, develop, plan and implement recreation activities in a community recreation center, institution (or similar organization), preschool, park or playground; determine the recreation needs of targeted groups or communities; evaluate program effectiveness and serves as an integral part of the recreation team; may act as Center Director at Neighborhood Centers and other large recreation facilities; all Recreation Supervisors perform related work.

**Special Working Conditions:** Recreation Supervisors may be required to work shifts including nights, Saturdays, Sundays, and holidays.

(This is a brief description of what you might do in this position and does not include all the duties of this position.)

**THE SALARY:** The current minimum salary is \$43,325 per annum. This rate is subject to change.

**HOW TO APPLY:** If you believe you are eligible to take this examination, you must submit an application using one of the following options:

- (1) **Online at the DCAS website:** Go to the Online Application System (OASys) at [www.nyc.gov/examsforjobs](http://www.nyc.gov/examsforjobs) and follow the onscreen application instructions for electronically submitting your application payment and completing any required forms. The following methods of payment are acceptable: major credit card, bank card associated with a bank account, or prepaid debit card which you may purchase online or at various retail outlets.
- (2) **By mail:** Fill out an "Application for Examination" form and return the completed form and application fee to DCAS Application Unit, 1 Centre Street, 14th floor, New York, NY 10007.

DCAS will not accept applications in person from candidates.

**Special Circumstances Form:** This form is included in the application package and located online at the above DCAS website. It gives important information about requesting an alternate test date because of religious observance or a special test accommodation for disability, claiming Veterans or Legacy credit, and notifying DCAS of a change in your mailing address. Follow all instructions on the Special Circumstances form that pertain to you when you complete your "Application for Examination."

You may be given the test before we verify your eligibility. You are responsible for determining whether or not you meet the eligibility requirements for this examination prior to submitting the application. If you are marked "Not Eligible," your application fee will not be refunded.

**ELIGIBILITY TO TAKE EXAMINATION:** This examination is open to each employee of an agency under the jurisdiction of the Commissioner, Department of Citywide Administrative Services who **on the date of the multiple-choice test:**

- (1) is permanently (not provisionally) employed in or appears on a Preferred List (see Note, below) for the title of Recreation Director; and
- (2) is not otherwise ineligible.

(Note: A "Preferred List" is a civil service list which is only for certain former permanent incumbents of the eligible title who have rehiring rights.)

If you do not know if you are eligible, check with **your agency's personnel office.**

**READ CAREFULLY AND SAVE FOR FUTURE REFERENCE**

**ELIGIBILITY TO BE PROMOTED:** In order to be eligible for promotion, you must have completed your probationary period in the eligible title as indicated in the above "Eligibility To Take Examination" section, and you must be permanently employed in the eligible title or your name must appear on a Preferred List for the eligible title at the time of promotion. Additionally, you must have served permanently in the eligible title for at least one year.

**THE TEST:** You will be given a multiple-choice test. You must achieve a score of at least 70% to pass this test. Your score on this test will determine 85% of your final score. Your seniority will determine the remaining 15%. You must pass the multiple-choice test to have your seniority credited. Your seniority score will be 70 plus ½ point for each three months of completed, permanent, continuous service with an agency under the jurisdiction of the Commissioner, Department of Citywide Administrative Services in competitive class titles. Your service will be credited through the date of the test, up to a maximum of 15 years. Time served prior to a break in service of more than one year will not be credited.

A more detailed description of the multiple-choice test will be provided at a later date.

**ADMISSION CARD:** You should receive an Admission Card in the mail about 10 days before the date of the test. If you do not receive an Admission Card at least 4 days before the test date, you must go to the Examining Service Section, 1 Centre Street, 14<sup>th</sup> floor, Manhattan, to obtain a duplicate card.

**THE TEST RESULTS:** If you pass the multiple-choice test and are marked eligible, your name will be placed in final score order on an eligible list and you will be given a list number. You will be notified by mail of your test results. If you meet all requirements and conditions, you will be considered for promotion when your name is reached on the eligible list.

**SPECIAL ARRANGEMENTS:**

**Late Filing:** Consult **your agency's personnel office** to determine the procedure for filing a late application if you meet one or more of the following conditions:

- (1) You are absent from work for at least one-half of the application period and cannot apply for reasons such as vacation, sick leave or military duty; or
- (2) You become eligible after the above application period but on or before the date of the multiple-choice test.

**Make-up Test:** You may apply for a make-up test if you cannot take the test on the regular test date for any of the following reasons:

- (1) compulsory attendance before a public body;
- (2) on-the-job injury or illness caused by municipal employment;
- (3) absence for one week following the death of a spouse, domestic partner, parent, sibling, child or child of a domestic partner;
- (4) absence due to ordered military duty; or
- (5) a clear error for which the Department of Citywide Administrative Services or the examining agency is responsible.

To request a make-up test, contact the Examining Service Section, 1 Centre Street, 14<sup>th</sup> floor, New York, NY 10007, in person or by certified mail as soon as possible and provide documentation of the special circumstances.
