Install New Concrete Pedestrian Islands

Simpler Safer Left Turns

NYC DOT will implement street safety improvements on 10th Ave. between W 14th St. and W 38th St.:

- Install curbside, parking protected bike lanes between W 14th St. and W 38th St.
- Install painted or concrete pedestrian islands at intersections
- Install signal changes at 27th St. and add protected pedestrian crossing time
- Install ADA compliant pedestrian ramps at intersections

Implementation begins in late-May
