NYC DOT will implement street safety improvements on 160th St. from Archer Ave. to Tuskegee Airmen Way:


- Create protected two-way micromobility and pedestrian path along west curb
- Add curb extensions to midblock crossings at York College campus
- Add daylighting and curb extensions at Liberty Ave., Tuskegee Airmen Way
