NYC DOT will implement pedestrian and bike safety improvements on 165th Ave. between 84th St. and Cross Bay Blvd.:

- Install a two-way parking protected bike lane on the south side of 165th Ave. between 84th St. and Cross Bay Blvd.
- Install a pedestrian island at 165th Ave. and Cross Bay Blvd.
- Resurface 165th Ave. between 83rd St. and Cross Bay Blvd.
- Upgrade and refurbish high visibility crosswalks along 165th Ave.
- Install vehicular travel lane markings along 165th Ave.

Implementation begins September 2021
