


Routes Prioritized in Community Workshops











Proposed - Pitkin Avenue: Legion St to Pennsylvania Ave




Proposed - Pitkin Avenue: Legion St to Pennsylvania Ave



Existing - Pitkin Avenue: Pennsylvania Ave to Fountain Ave




Proposed - Pitkin Avenue: Pennsylvania Ave to Fountain Ave


