



Outreach History

- LAGCC Survey (May 2022)
 - 515 Respondents (47% BIPOC, 23% Students)
 - Majority of people use public transportation as a primary mode (80%)
 - Top public realm suggestions included more greenery (62%), more public space (50%), pedestrian circulation space (55%) and more seating (33%)
- Briefings w/ CM Won (Jan 2024 + April 2025)
 - Update on LIC Public Realm Improvements
 - Update on 29th Street SIP
- LAGCC Outreach (March April 2025)
 - Discussion with administration on design options for 29th Street SIP
 - On street student engagement






We want you to have a safe and enjoyable time. Be courteous and respectful to others, and please keep the plaza clean.

Pedestrian Plaza Rules Prohibit:

- Obstruction of pedestrian traffic
- Destruction, removal or tampering of any property or equipment
- Camping
- Unattended property
- A person or their belongings taking up more than one seat
- Consumption of alcoholic beverages, except as otherwise permitted
- Skateboarding
- Feeding of undomesticated animals
- Spitting, urination, defecation
- Unreasonable noise
- Dogs off-leash



Permits are required for all events

Bicycle riding is only permitted on designated routes or where indicated by signage or markings
