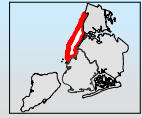


# Fifth/Madison Avenue Bus Priority

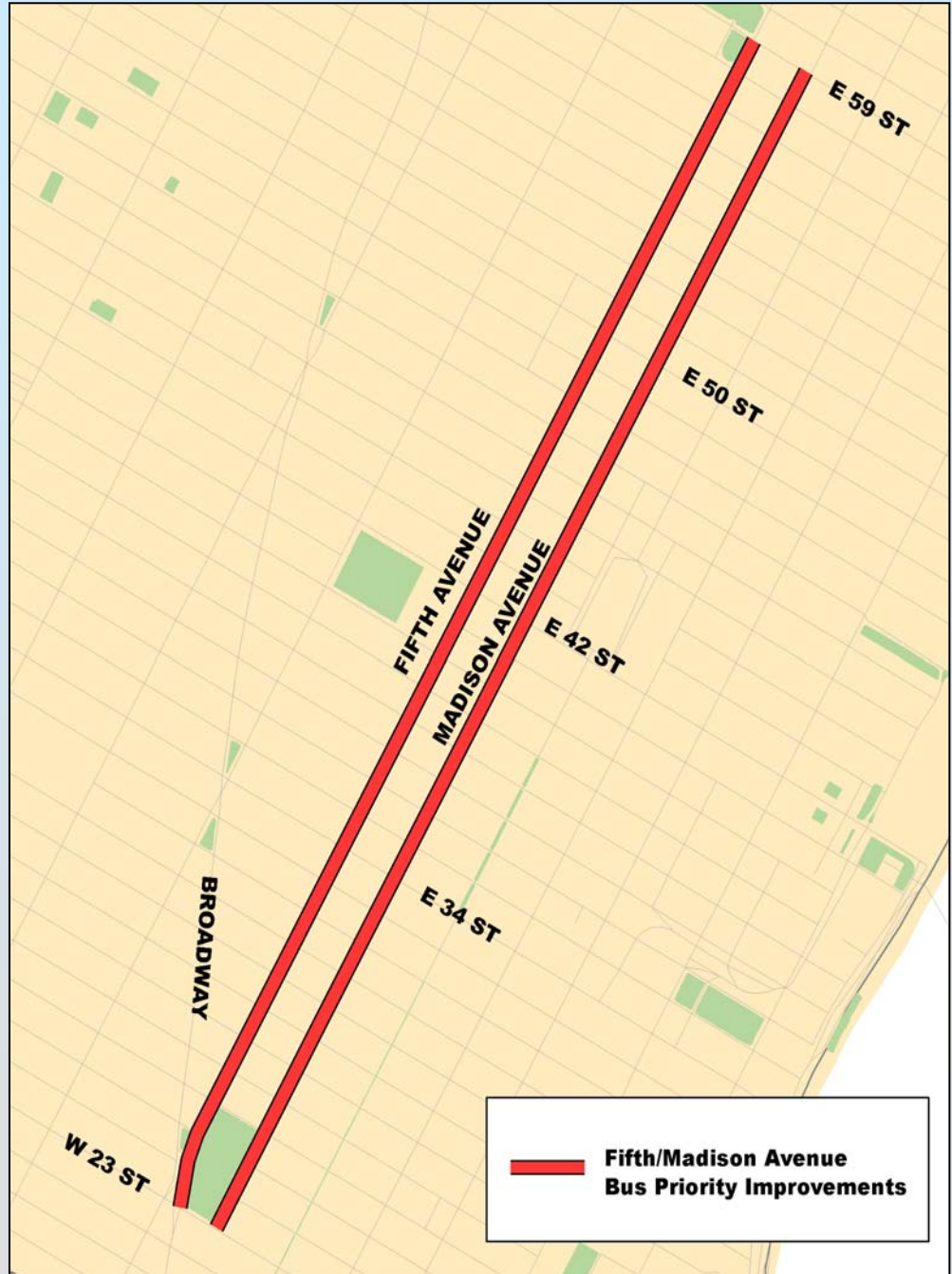


## The Corridor

The **Fifth/Madison Avenue** Bus Priority Corridor extends between 23<sup>rd</sup> Street and 59<sup>th</sup> Street in Manhattan. The corridor is currently served by the M1, M2, M3, M4, M5 and Q32 buses, and a number of express buses from all outer boroughs. On an average weekday, 101,500 transit passengers ride the M1 – M5 buses, and 14,300 ride the Q32.

## Bus Priority Operations

- 5th Avenue converted to double bus lane, extended to 23rd street
- Madison Avenue double bus lane extended to 23rd street
- Bus lanes painted red and additional overhead signage
- Faster travel times on **Local, Limited and Express** service: Limited and express buses will be able to pass stopped locals without entering general traffic
- Will improve travel times by up to 20% through the corridor
