Dear Commissioner Forgione:

I write to ask that you evaluate the appropriateness of widening a pair of existing Greenstreets, located at 66th Street and Second Avenue, and 66th Street and Third Avenue.

Currently, the perimeters of the Greenstreets are designated "No Standing Anytime" zones. Nonetheless, vehicles with parking placards park in those zones on a daily basis, apparently without obstructing the flow of traffic. If, indeed, traffic is not obstructed by the presence of these vehicles, it seems likely that it also would not be impeded by widened Greenstreets, which would provide greater benefit to the community. I ask you study the feasibility of expanding these Greenstreets, and inform me of your findings.
