




AMITY ST / DEAN ST BIKE ROUTE – GAP IN NETWORK

- Brooklyn Waterfront Greenway installed in 2011
- Gap in bike network:
 No eastbound route to Dean St from:
 - Brooklyn Waterfront Greenway and Congress St
 - Brooklyn Bridge and Henry St

SAFETY – Vision Zero




Amity St 2 Severe Cyclist Injuries; 9.2 per mile

Amity Street – Henry St to Court St

Injury Summary, 2010-2014 (5 years)


	Total Injuries	Severe Injuries	Fatalities

PROJECT PROPOSAL - Henry St to Court St

Install bicycle lanes

- Provide dedicated space on street for cyclists
- Narrower moving lanes calm traffic
- · No impact on parking




INTERSECTION IMPROVEMENTS: Amity St at Court St

Amity St and Court St intersection will be improved to include:

- New Crosswalk on north side of Dean St
 - Increase pedestrian mobility
 - Maintain intersection clear of vehicles
- Bicycle Intersection Markings
 - Provide wayfinding for people on bicycles
 - Minimize pedestrian conflicts






Amity St at Court St: Proposed Design

INTERSECTION IMPROVEMENTS: Amity St at Court St

New signs will be installed including:

- NO LEFT TURN; EXCEPT BIKES
 - Maintains existing motor vehicle mobility
 - Improves cyclist mobility





- BIKES YIELD TO PEDS/ USE PED SIGNAL
 - Supersedes existing right turn arrow for bicyclists
 - Retains pedestrian priority in intersection



Amity St

- Fills gap between Brooklyn Bridge/ Brooklyn Waterfront Greenway and Dean St for eastbound cyclists
- New pedestrian crossing increases pedestrian safety
- Maintains vehicular mobility
- Limited impacts to parking

Expand Carroll Gardens bike networks, improve mobility, enhance safety for growing number of cyclists
