**NYC DOT will implement safety improvements on Amsterdam Ave./Ft. George Ave. next to P.S. 189, P.S. 138 and George Washington Educational Campus:**

- Install parking protected bicycle lanes on Amsterdam Ave./Ft. George Ave. from W. 188th St. to St. Nicholas Ave.
- Install concrete pedestrian islands and a bus boarding island on Amsterdam Ave. at W. 189th St. and at W. 190th St.
- Install painted curb extensions and angled parking on W. 190th St. from Amsterdam Ave. to Wadsworth Ave.
