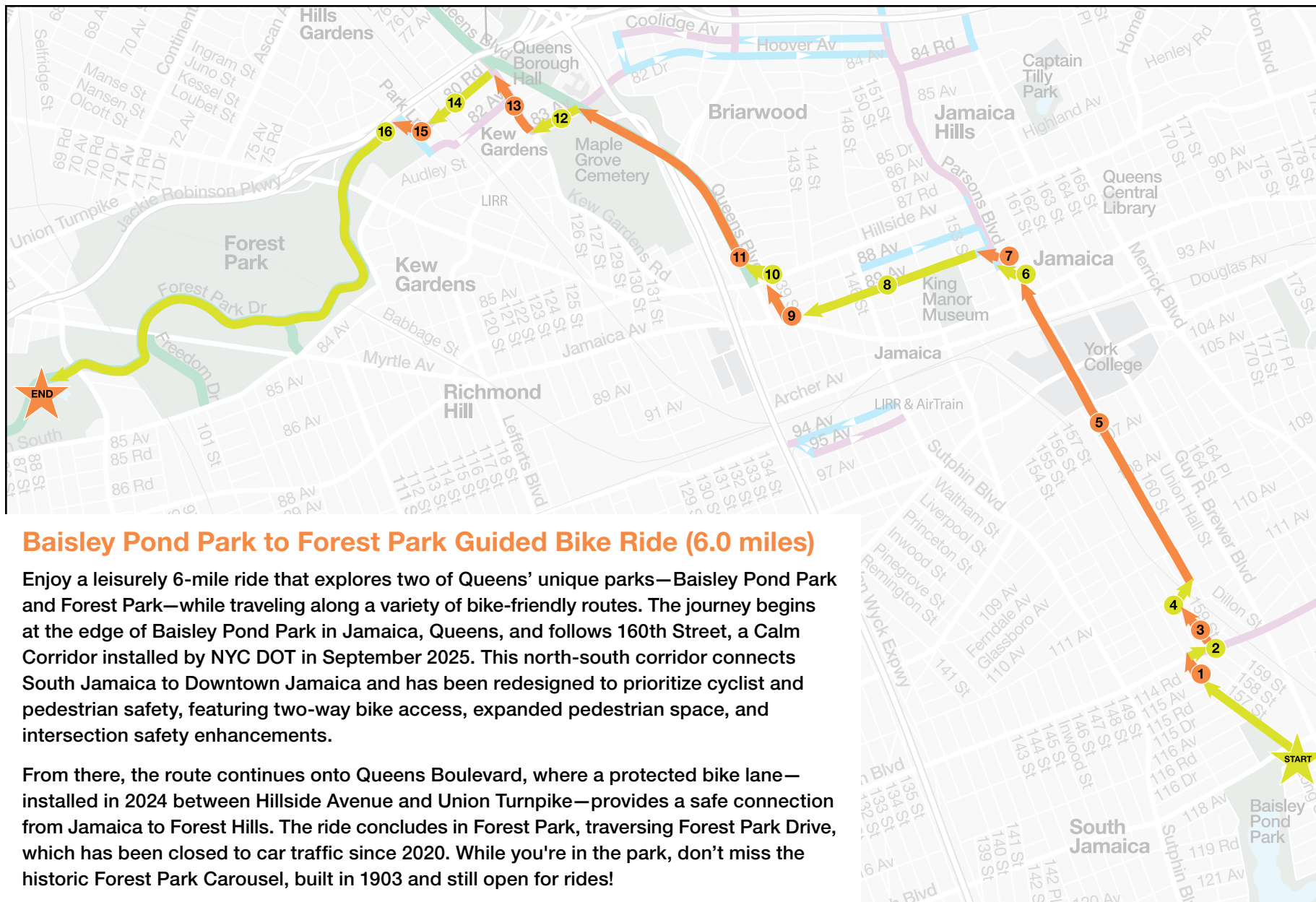

Baisley Pond Park to Forest Park Guided Bike Ride (6.0 miles)

Enjoy a leisurely 6-mile ride that explores two of Queens' unique parks—Baisley Pond Park and Forest Park—while traveling along a variety of bike-friendly routes. The journey begins at the edge of Baisley Pond Park in Jamaica, Queens, and follows 160th Street, a Calm Corridor installed by NYC DOT in September 2025. This north-south corridor connects South Jamaica to Downtown Jamaica and has been redesigned to prioritize cyclist and pedestrian safety, featuring two-way bike access, expanded pedestrian space, and intersection safety enhancements.

From there, the route continues onto Queens Boulevard, where a protected bike lane—installed in 2024 between Hillside Avenue and Union Turnpike—provides a safe connection from Jamaica to Forest Hills. The ride concludes in Forest Park, traversing Forest Park Drive, which has been closed to car traffic since 2020. While you're in the park, don't miss the historic Forest Park Carousel, built in 1903 and still open for rides!
