Safer Pedestrian Crossings

Slower, Safer Turns

Bowne Street, Sanford Avenue to Roosevelt Avenue Pedestrian Safety Improvements

Reduce Speeding

Improve Roadway Organization

NYC DOT will implement safety improvements on the Vision Zero Priority Corridor of Bowne Street between Sanford Avenue and Roosevelt Avenue:

- Install two concrete pedestrian islands in the existing channelization area at 41st Avenue and Barclay Avenue
- Restrict northbound left turn from Bowne Street to 41st Avenue
- Adjust flush median and moving lanes to standard width
- Upgrade pedestrian ramps to ADA compliance

Implementation starts in June
