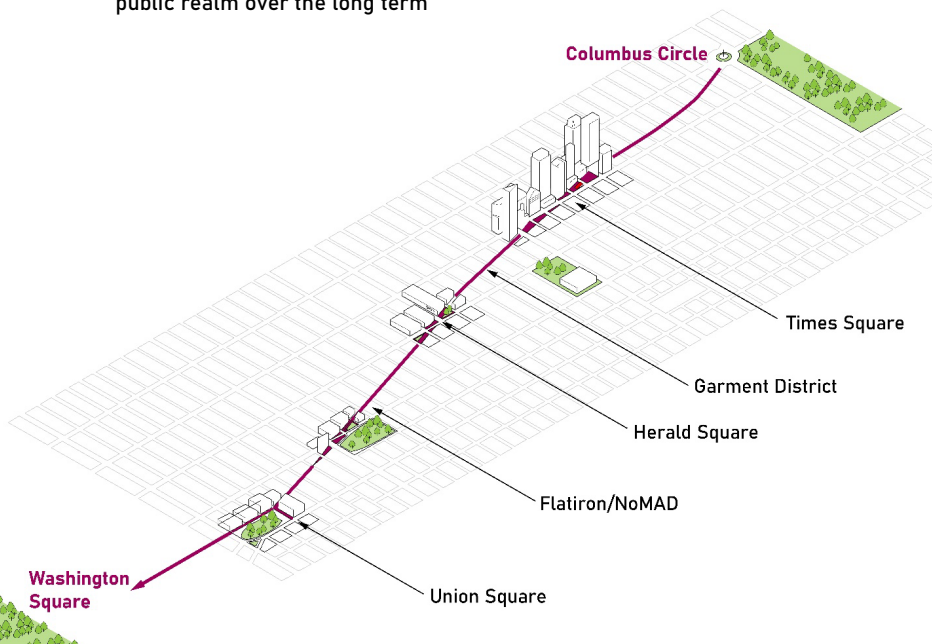

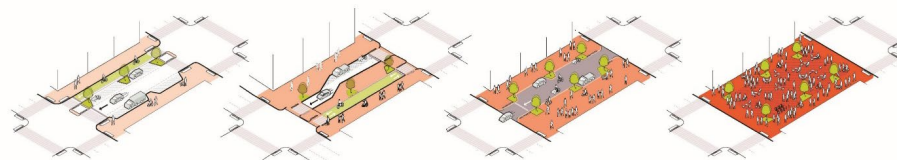
Broadway Vision

Comprehensive Public Realm Plan

- Create a vibrant and safe Broadway to support local commerce, community, and culture
- Prioritize pedestrians and cyclists while creating slow-speed local vehicle access where and when needed
- Create more premier plazas to amplify each unique neighborhood
- Create corridor wide management and operational initiatives to support the public realm over the long term

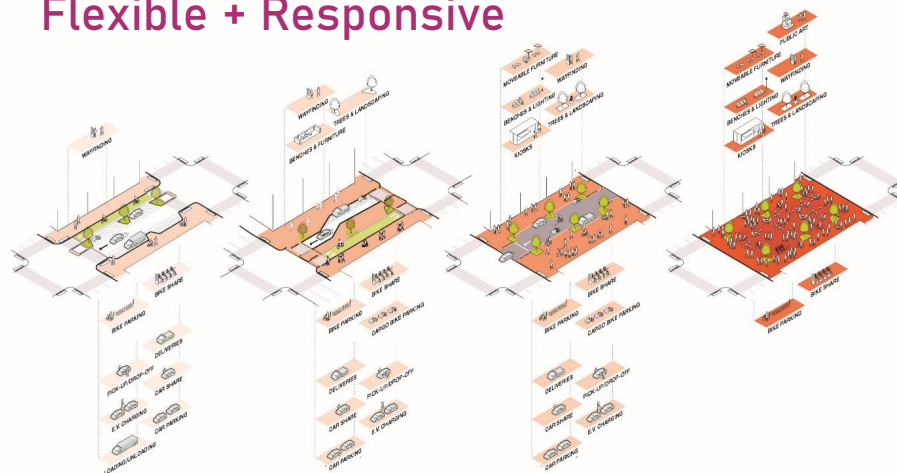

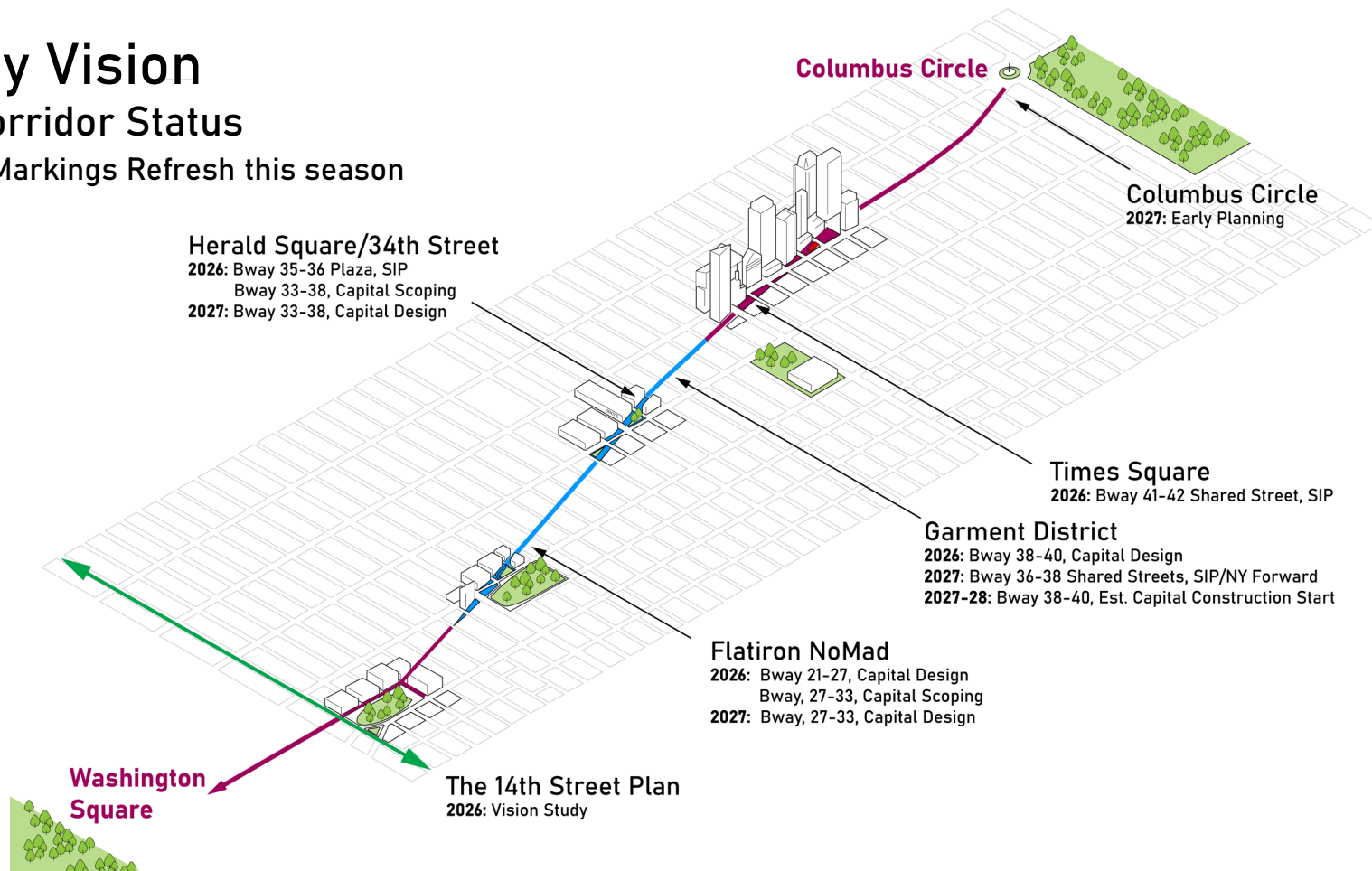

- Corridor Markings Refresh this season

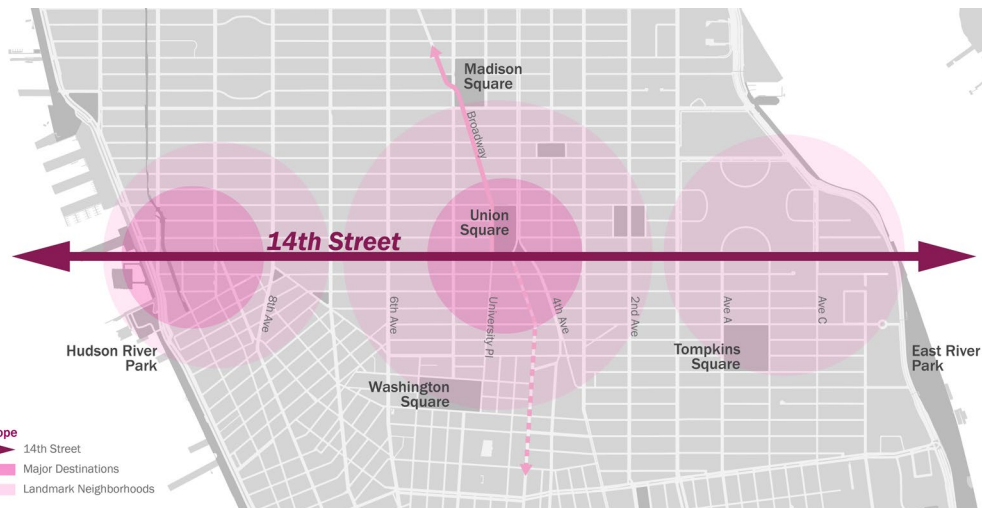


Union Square

Partner, Union Square BID

- The 14th Street Plan Goals
 - Transform 14th Street into a future forward, green, and rapid bus corridor that centers the pedestrian experience and enhances safety for all users.
 - Update infrastructure, enhance accessibility + cycling amenities
 - Modernize USQ Park
 - Study economic benefits + leverage private funding
 - Streamline capital scope development

Broadway, 21-31

Partner, Flatiron NoMad BID

- Capital Project, Broadway 21-27
 - Currently in Final Design
 - Public Workshop & CB presentation this Fall
 - Estimated Construction start 2028
- Capital Project, Broadway 27-31
 - Design Procurement
- Major Concession ULURP completed

Partner, 34th Street Partnership

- New plaza block completed in Spring 2026
- Capital Project, Broadway 31-36
 - Design Procurement

Garment District

Broadway, 36-41

Partner, Garment District Alliance

- SIP Refresh, 36-38 + 40-41
 - Updated design and materials to align with capital project
 - Part of NY Forward Funding
- Capital Project, Broadway 36-38
 - Design Procurement
- Capital Project, Broadway 38-40
 - Currently in Final Design
 - Estimated Construction start 27-28

Times Square

Broadway, 41-53

Partner, Times Square Alliance

- Major Concession ULURP Complete
- New Shared Street Block 41-42 implemented earlier this year
- DOT in early planning stages for northern section of the corridor including Columbus Circle

MSMX Points of Agreement Broadway Vision

- Add 2 car-free blocks along the corridor
 - DOT to get feedback at public workshops and preset to CB 5
- Apply family-friendly design
 - Upcoming call for Kid-Friendly Play Elements in the MSMX zone, Flatiron to Garment District
