

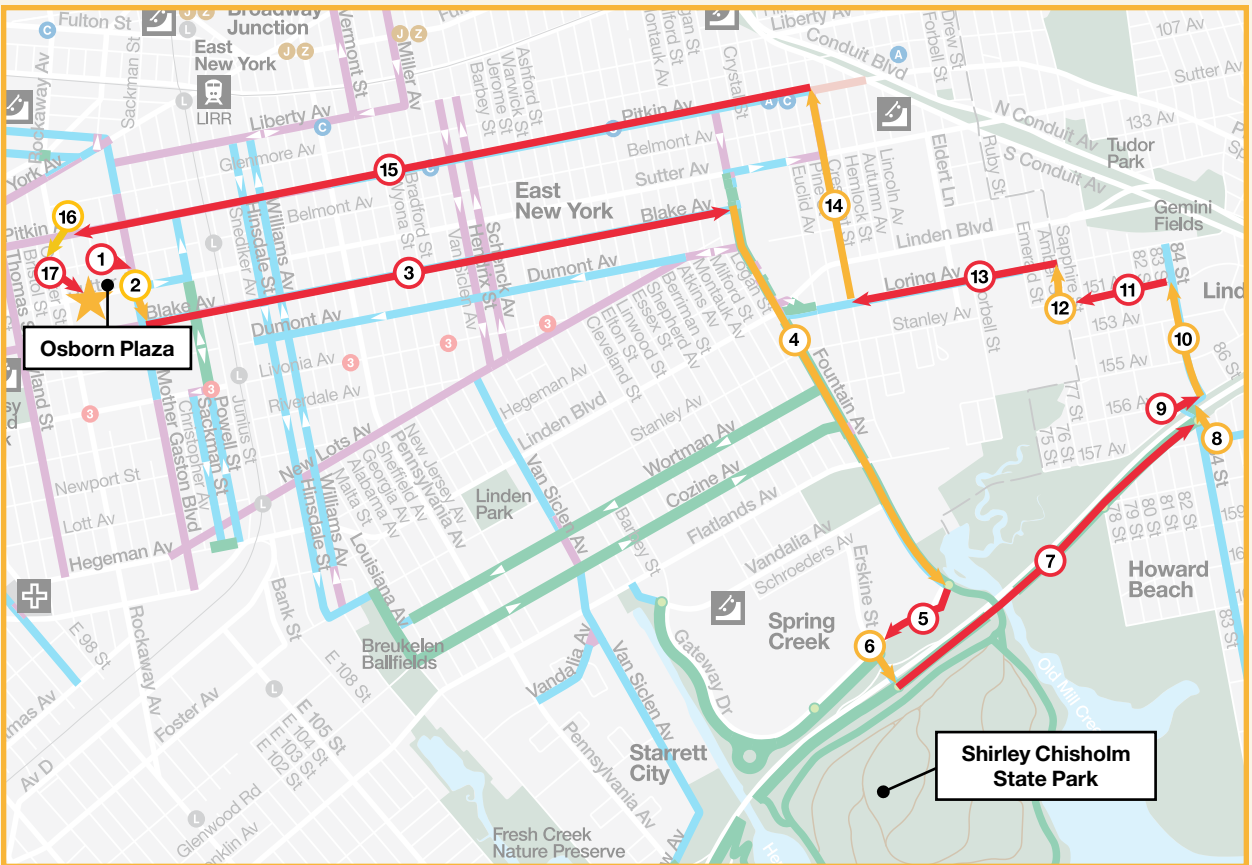

Brownsville and East New York Bike Tour (9.1 Miles)

New York/New Jersey is proud to be a host region for the 2026 FIFA World Cup™. To celebrate, NYC DOT has created a series of self-guided bike rides through some of the City’s most culturally vibrant neighborhoods.

This 9.2-mile self-guided ride begins and ends at **Osborn Plaza** in Brownsville, a former dead-end street that has been transformed into a NYC DOT public plaza in collaboration with the Brownsville Community Justice Center. From Osborn Plaza, the route travels along Blake Avenue before continuing onto a protected bike lane on Fountain Avenue and connecting to the Jamaica Bay Greenway, a scenic waterfront path that winds along the shores of Jamaica Bay.

The route also passes near **Shirley Chisholm State Park**, named for the Brooklyn-born trailblazer who in 1968 became the first Black woman elected to Congress and in 1972 became the first Black candidate to seek a major party presidential nomination. The park, which opened in 2019 along the Jamaica Bay waterfront, has gravel paths and beautiful vistas, is great to enjoy by bicycle. The ride then returns through the neighborhood via Pitkin Avenue, one of Brownsville’s commercial corridors, ending at Osborn Plaza.
