
2022 Program Vision

Priority Investment Areas


- Priority Investment Areas (PIA) is an overlay of inputs that create a framework for prioritizing transportation-related investments city-wide and address issues of equity concerns.*
- Cooper Park Area is Priority Investment Area Tier 2
- NYC Streets Plan (2021) outcomes
 - Prioritization framework for future developments citywide
 - Identifies concrete goals and potential locations
 - · Equity as a guiding principle






Public Survey


- Survey launched October 2021

- Create dedicated bike parking areas






