


Fatalities, 01/02018-2022: 1

- Surrounded by **Vision Zero** Priority Areas
- Within a Bike Priority District
 - High cyclist KSI & low coverage
- Fatality at Cooper and Irving in 2021
- Pedestrian struck twice at Cypress Ave and Cooper Ave while crossing from west to east in 2022



Background – Issues

- Few protected bike lanes in CB5
- Lack of connections to Bushwick Neighborhood Bicycle Network, Highland Park Greenway and Cypress Hills St PBL
- Highland Park difficult to access for both cyclists and pedestrians
- Commercial vehicles park on Cypress Ave overnight



Issues: Missing Sidewalks (Vermont PI and Cypress Av)

- 1) Missing sidewalks on north side of Cypress Av
- (2) Missing sidewalks on east side of Vermont Pl








Citi Bike

Cycling in Numbers

- 15% of New Yorkers use bike share (Mobility Survey, 2018)
- 19.5 million Citi Bike trips in 2020
- Citi Bike regularly serves over 80,000 trips per day
- Citi Bike expansion area reached Queens CB5 in 2023



Safety Benefits of Protected Bike Lanes

Protected bike lanes benefit all street users:

Crashes with Injuries
Down 15%


Motor Vehicle
Occupant Injuries
Down 15%

Pedestrian Injuries Down 21%

Injuries to cyclists increase only 3%, despite a 61% increase in bike volume increase

Protected Bike Lanes

Before and After Crash Data, 2007 - 2017





Data from 25 separate protected bicycle lane projects installed from 2007-2014 with 3 years of after data. Includes portions of 1 Ave, 2 Ave, 8 Ave, 9 Ave, Broadway, Columbus Ave, Hudson St, Lafayette St / 4 Ave, Sands St, Allen/Pike St, Kent Ave, Prospect Park West, Flushing Ave, Bruckner Blvd & Longfellow Ave, Imlay St / Conover St, Paerdegat Ave. Only sections of projects that included protected bike lanes were analyzed. 

Decatur St (Evergreen Av - Cypress Av)


Cooper St / Cooper Av (Evergreen Av to Cypress Av)




Cypress Ave

Cypress Hills St – Vermont Pl

- Install two-way protected bike lane on the north curb
- Establish No Standing Anytime on north curb of Cypress Ave







Cypress Ave

Vermont PI - Cabot Rd

- Install two-way protected bike lane on the north curb
- Remove rush hour regulation on north curb







Vermont PI

Cypress Ave – Highland Park

- · Eliminate double lefts at Cypress Ave
- Delay heavy right turns across Vermont Ave crosswalk
- Construct new sidewalks to improve bike and pedestrian connections to Highland Park.







Cypress Ave

Cabot Rd – Cooper Ave

- Install two-way protected bike lane on the north curb
- Remove 3 parking spaces on south curb
- Provide No Standing Anytime at approach to Cooper Ave






Future




Vermont PI, Cooper Ave, Decatur St

Cypress Ave – Highland Park

- Provide bicycle and pedestrian connections to Highland Park Greenway
- Provide intersection improvements pending further analysis (i.e. additional crosswalk, curb extensions) at Cooper Ave and on Vermont PI
- Provide connections to Bushwick Bicycle Network





Summary



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- Establish new protected bike lanes in CB5
- Provide bike and pedestrian access to Highland Park
- Connect to existing bike network
- Fill in gaps in pedestrian network by constructing new sidewalks
- Discourage overnight commercial vehicle parking on Cypress Ave
