





Prioritize pedestrians over cars by widening sidewalks and creating a network of curbless shared streets throughout Downtown Brooklyn's core.

INFRASTRUCTURE FOR PEOPLE

Upgrade infrastructure to create safe and efficient commutes that strengthen our economy by improving bike connectivity, streamlining the bus network, and enhancing the pedestrian experience.

INCREASE BIODIVERSITY


Plant 1,000 new trees and maximize green infrastructure wherever possible using in-ground and raised planters and raingardens to create a greener and healthier downtown.





- Maintain vehicular access for pick up / drop off








Hoyt, Fulton to Livingston




- Maintain vehicular access

- Add asphalt art in all pedestrian spaces





Hoyt, Livingston to Schermerhorn

- Slow through traffic
- Accommodate pick up drop off in the mid block
- Prioritize pedestrians and cyclists






Elm, Fulton to Livingston

- Add circulation space around the subway station entrances

- Add asphalt art in all pedestrian spaces






Elm, Fulton to Livingston

Elm, Fulton to Livingston




