Project Location

- East 169 St is a Vision Zero Priority Corridor
- Signal study at East 169 St
 / Rev James A Polite Ave /
 Lyman PI approved in 2023
- Almost 50 pedestrians per hour crossing East 169 St at peak

Existing Conditions

No traffic signal, missing crosswalks

Extensive unprotected area for pedestrians

Existing Conditions

Intersection configuration leads to unpredictable vehicle and pedestrian movements

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High pedestrian demand for multiple crossings: ~50 pedestrians per hour

Proposal

New traffic signal across E 169 St, to provide safe crossing for vehicles, pedestrians, cyclists

Three new crosswalks, to meet current pedestrian use patterns

New left turn restriction for low volume turns from Rev James A Polite Ave and Lyman PI, to allow for crosswalk installations New concrete island & painted pedestrian area, to calm traffic and provide safe refuge for pedestrians

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
Turn Bans and Alternate Routes

Alternate Routes




Low volume
