NYC DOT will implement safety and mobility improvements at the intersection of East 169th St., Rev James A Polite Ave. and Lyman Pl.:

- New traffic signal
- Concrete pedestrian island and painted pedestrian area to replace existing yellow channelization between Rev James A Polite Ave. and Lyman Pl.
- Three new crosswalks across East 169th St.
- Restriction of northbound left turns from Rev James A Polite Ave. and southbound left turns from Lyman Pl.

Implementation begins June 2024
