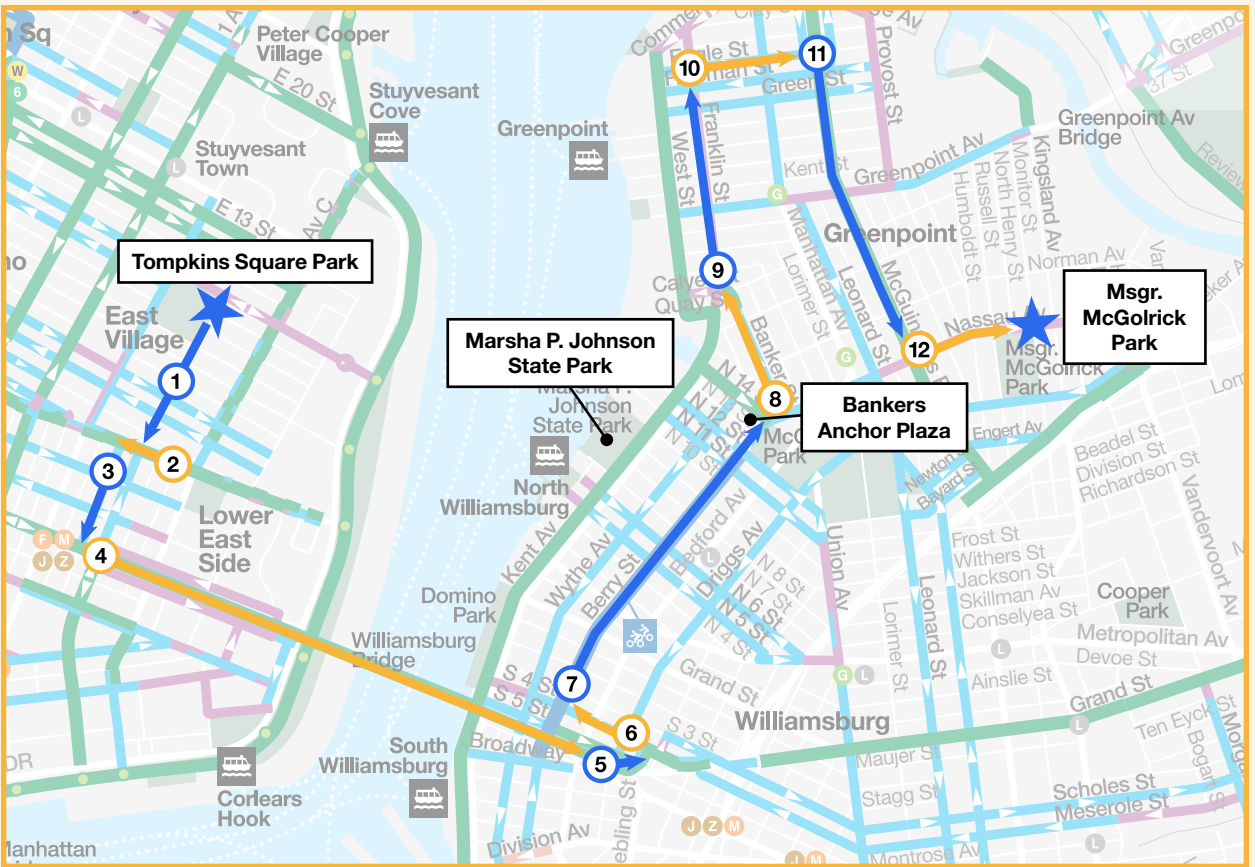

East Village to Greenpoint Bike Tour (5.7 Miles)

New York/New Jersey is proud to be a host region for the 2026 FIFA World Cup™. To celebrate, NYC DOT has created a series of self-guided bike rides through some of the city's most culturally vibrant neighborhoods.

The United States vs. Australia match takes place on Friday, June 19th, at 3 PM. Join friends and neighbors at the NYC DOT Soccer Streets Watch Party, hosted at Bankers Anchor Plaza!

This 5.7 mile self-guided ride begins at Tompkins Square Park, a historic public space and community anchor in the East Village. From there, the route travels south on Avenue B, and over the Williamsburg Bridge, a major suspension bridge connecting Manhattan and Brooklyn, completed in 1903. Once in Brooklyn, you will ride down Berry Street, a permanent open street great for walking and cycling. A nearby destination is Marsha P. Johnson State Park, named in honor of the pioneering American activist and transgender rights trailblazer who was a central figure in the 1969 Stonewall uprising and spent decades advocating for the most marginalized members of the LGBTQ+ community.

Continue down Berry Street, where you will ride by Bankers Anchor Plaza, a community plaza and gathering space in Greenpoint. The ride continues down McGuinness Boulevard, where a road diet and protected bike lane have been recently installed. The ride concludes at Msgr. McGolrick Park in Greenpoint, a park that has served the community for over a century.
