

Why are we here?


- Received request to close slip lane from Earl Monroe New Renaissance Basketball Charter School, which is opening at Elton Ave and E 153 St, near 3 Ave
- Large number of student pedestrians in the area during arrival and dismissal times
- 3 Ave is a Vision Zero Priority Corridor and in a Youth Injury Priority Area
- Courtlandt Ave, Morris Ave, and Park Ave project nearby

Existing Conditions

- Lightly used slip lane between E 153 St and 3 Ave
- Narrow sidewalk in front of school


Proposed


- Close Elton Ave slip lane (E 153 St to 3 Ave) to vehicles to expand pedestrian space in front of the school
- Net gain of one parking space
- Drivers on Elton Ave can access 3 Ave from E 154 St
