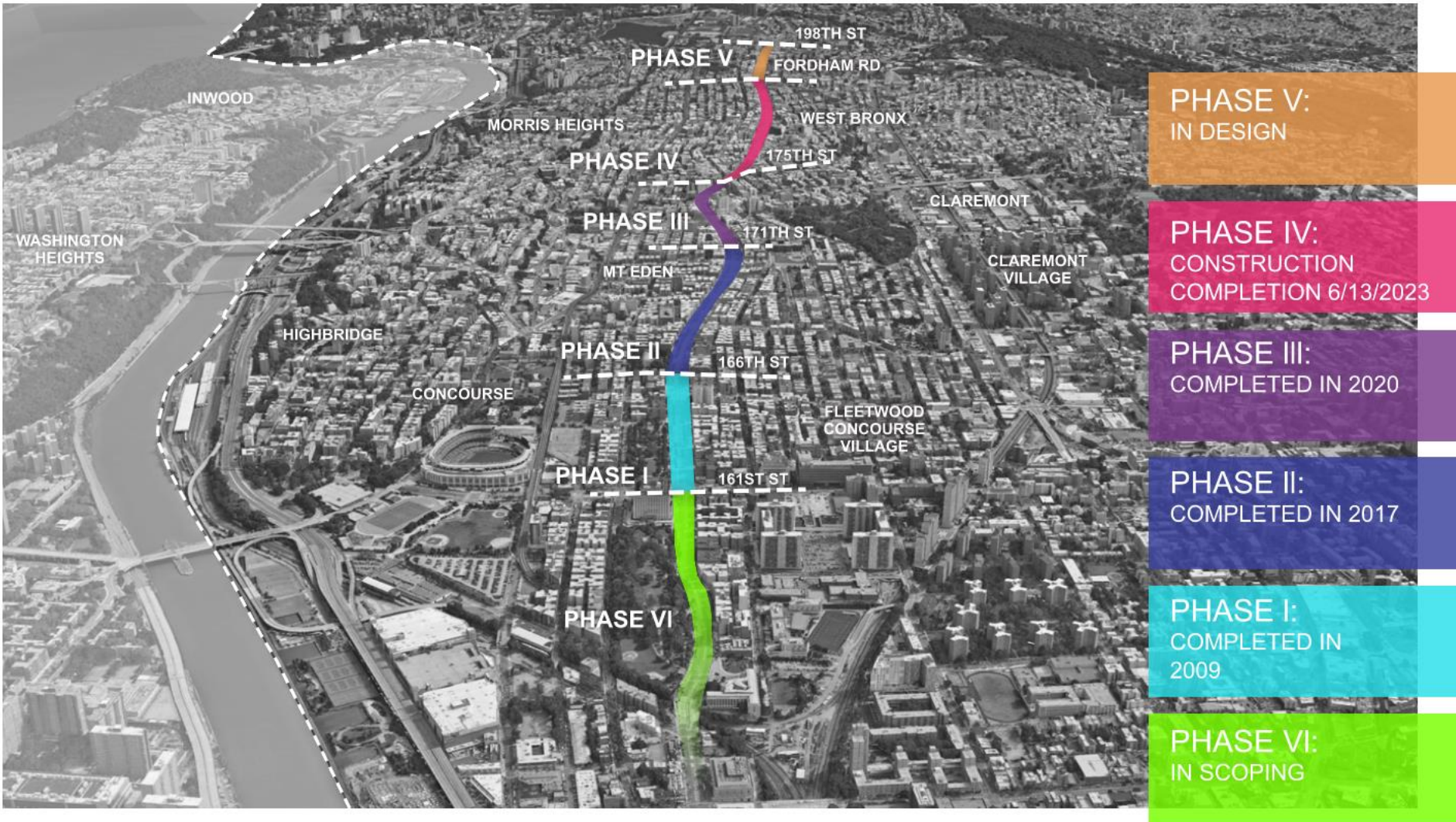

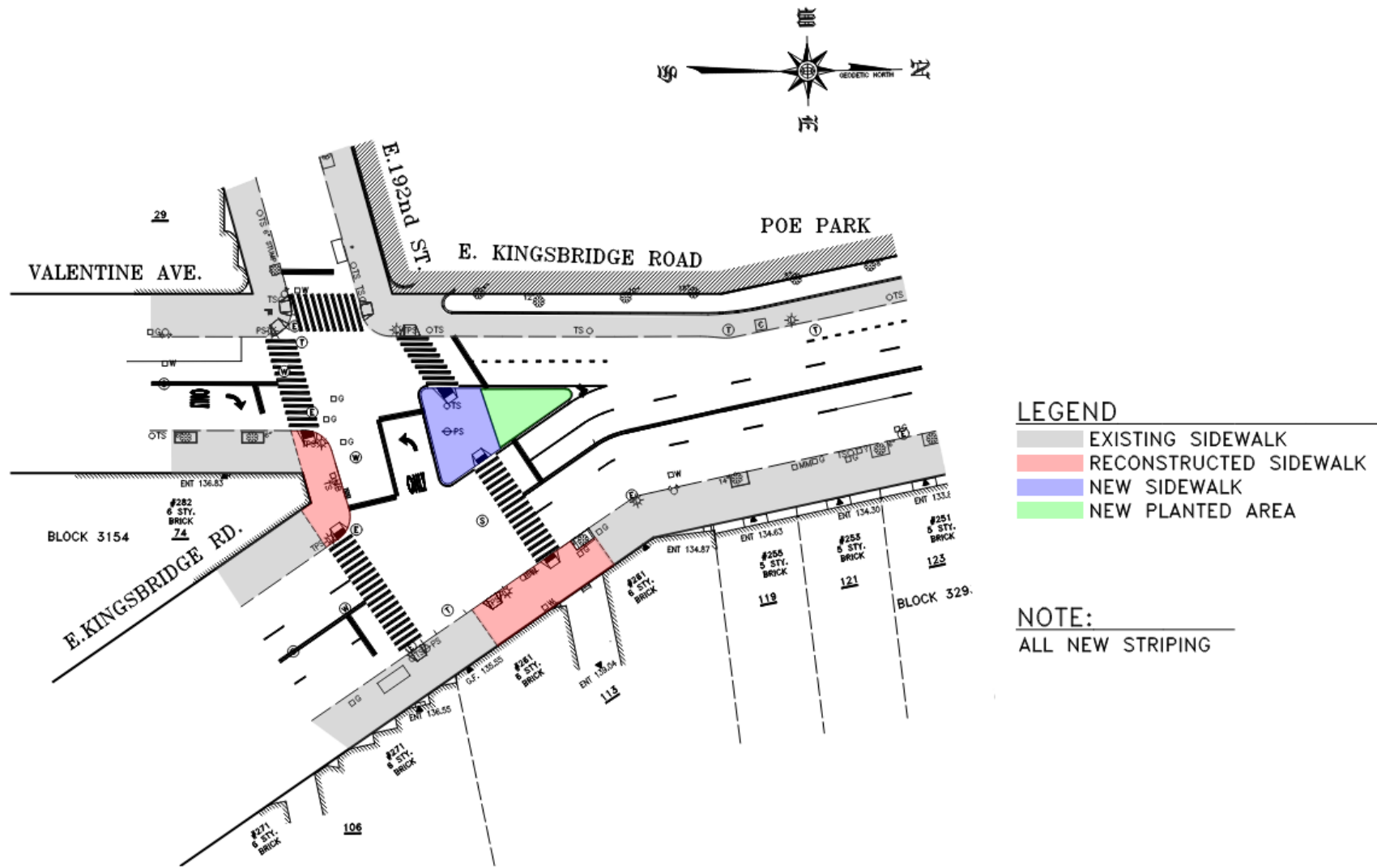

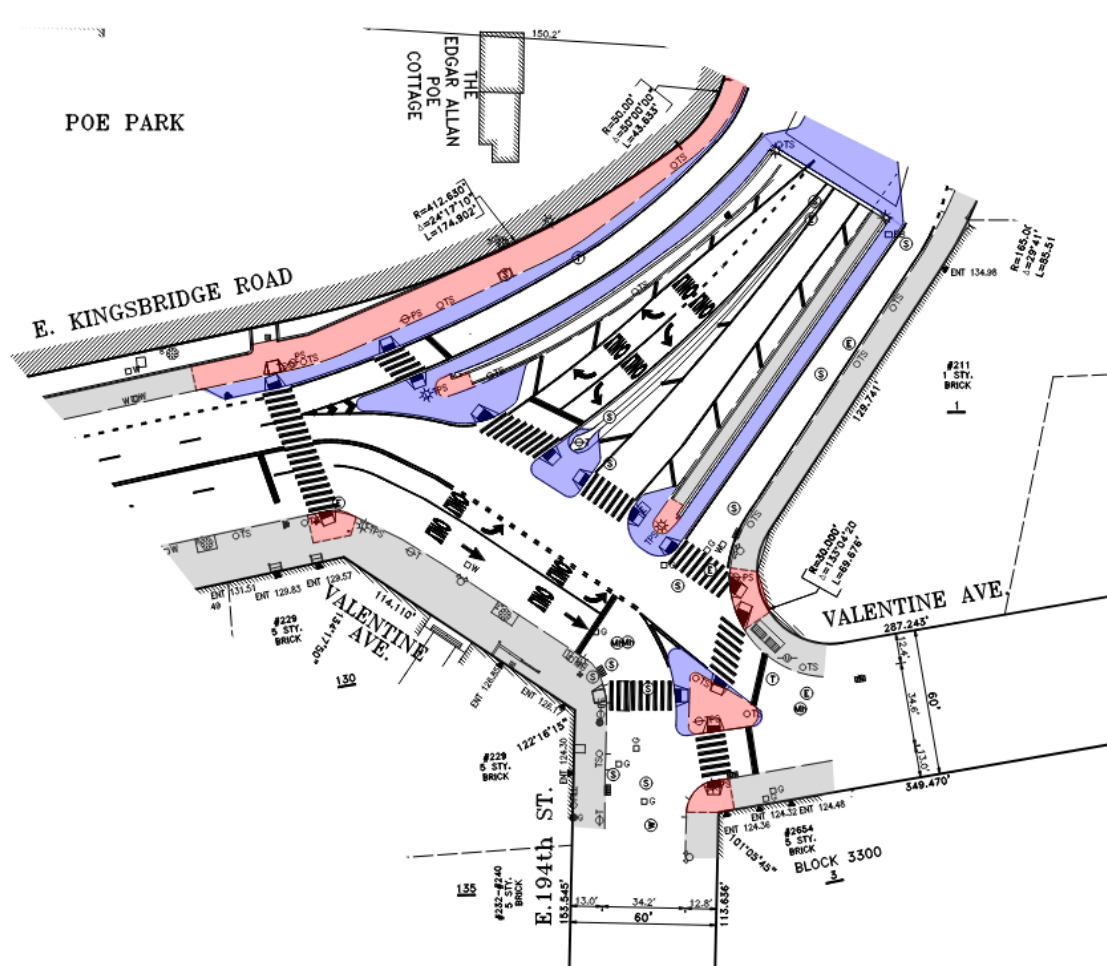
PHASE V EXTENTS

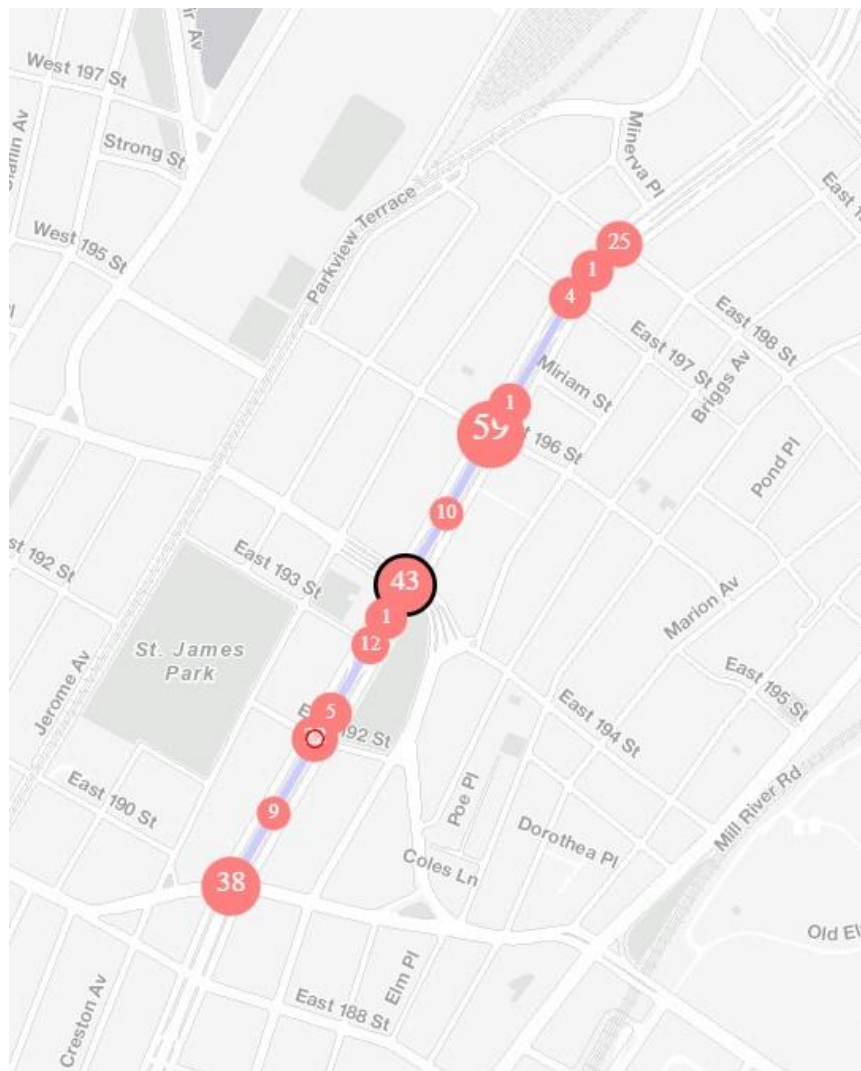

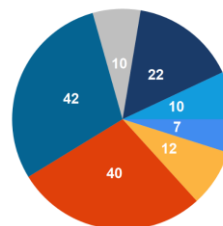

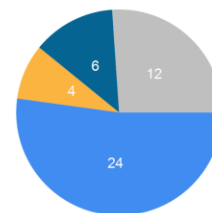
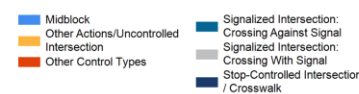

CURRENT SAFETY ISSUES

- Long crossings
- Inadequate refuge space
- Poor condition of medians
- Underutilized road space
- Unsafe usage of slip lanes and service roads
- Double parked cars blocking bike lanes

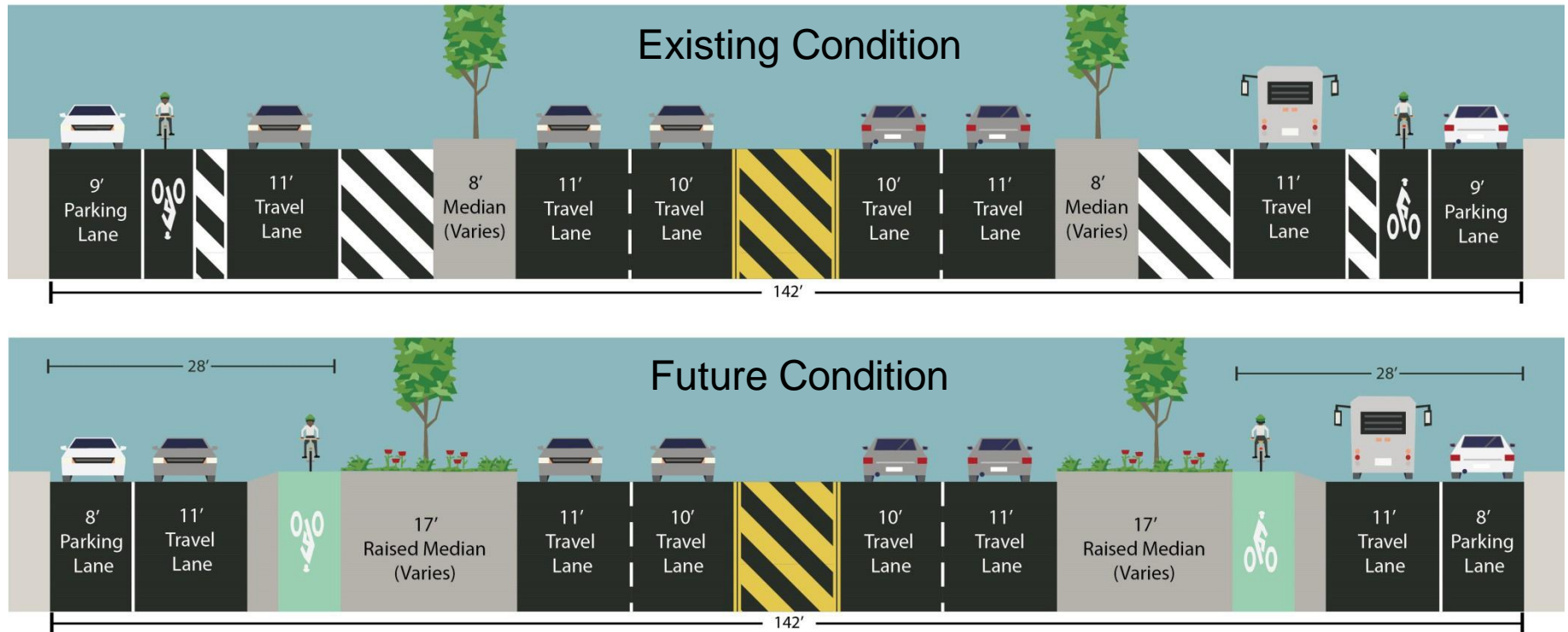


TRAFFIC CALMING & SAFETY MEASURES

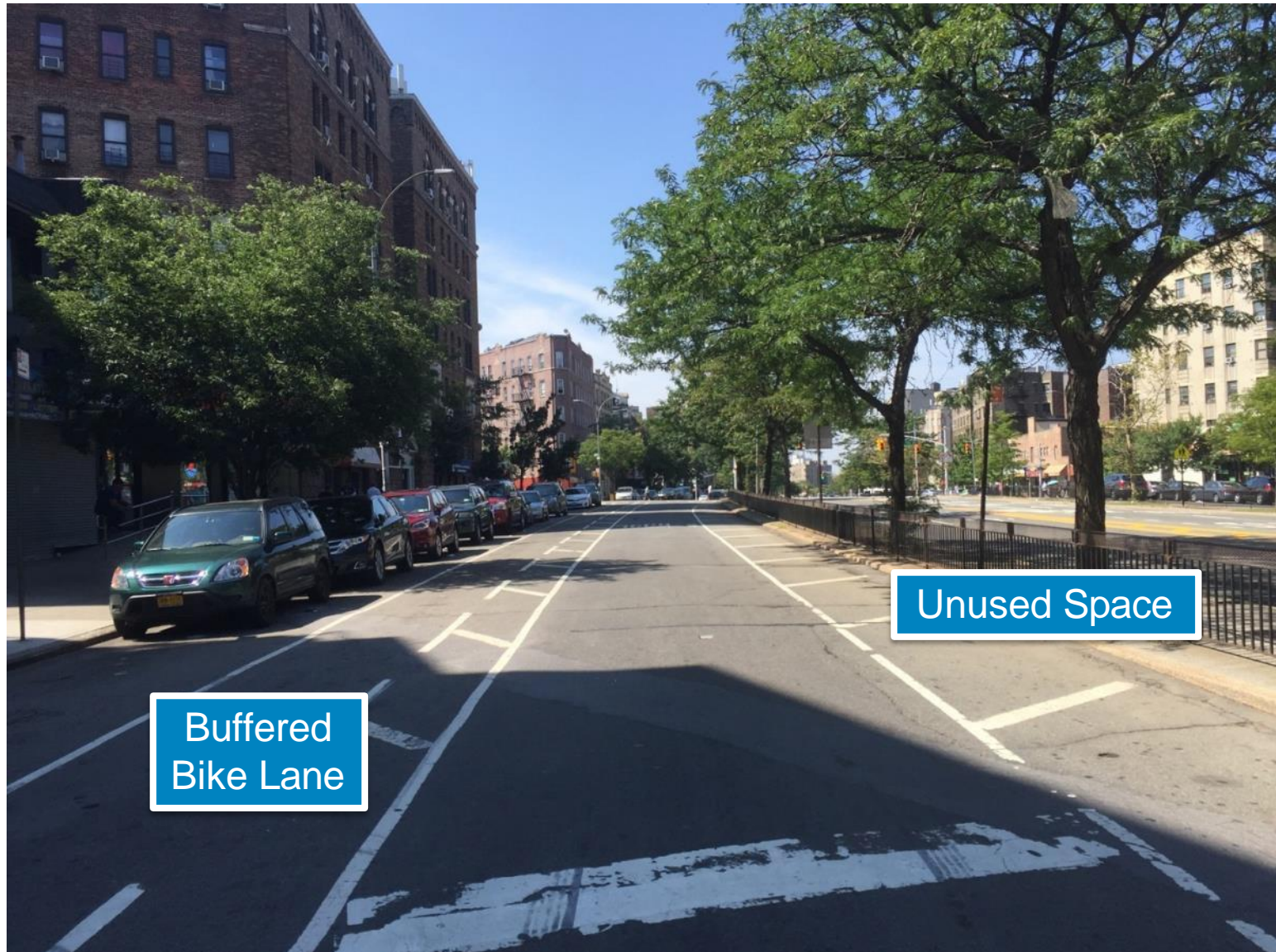
- Curb extensions
- Widened median
- Fully reconstructed medians with enhanced landscaping
- Buffered raised bike lane
- Stop-controlled slip lanes
- Raised crosswalks
- Updated signal timing



TYPICAL CROSS SECTION



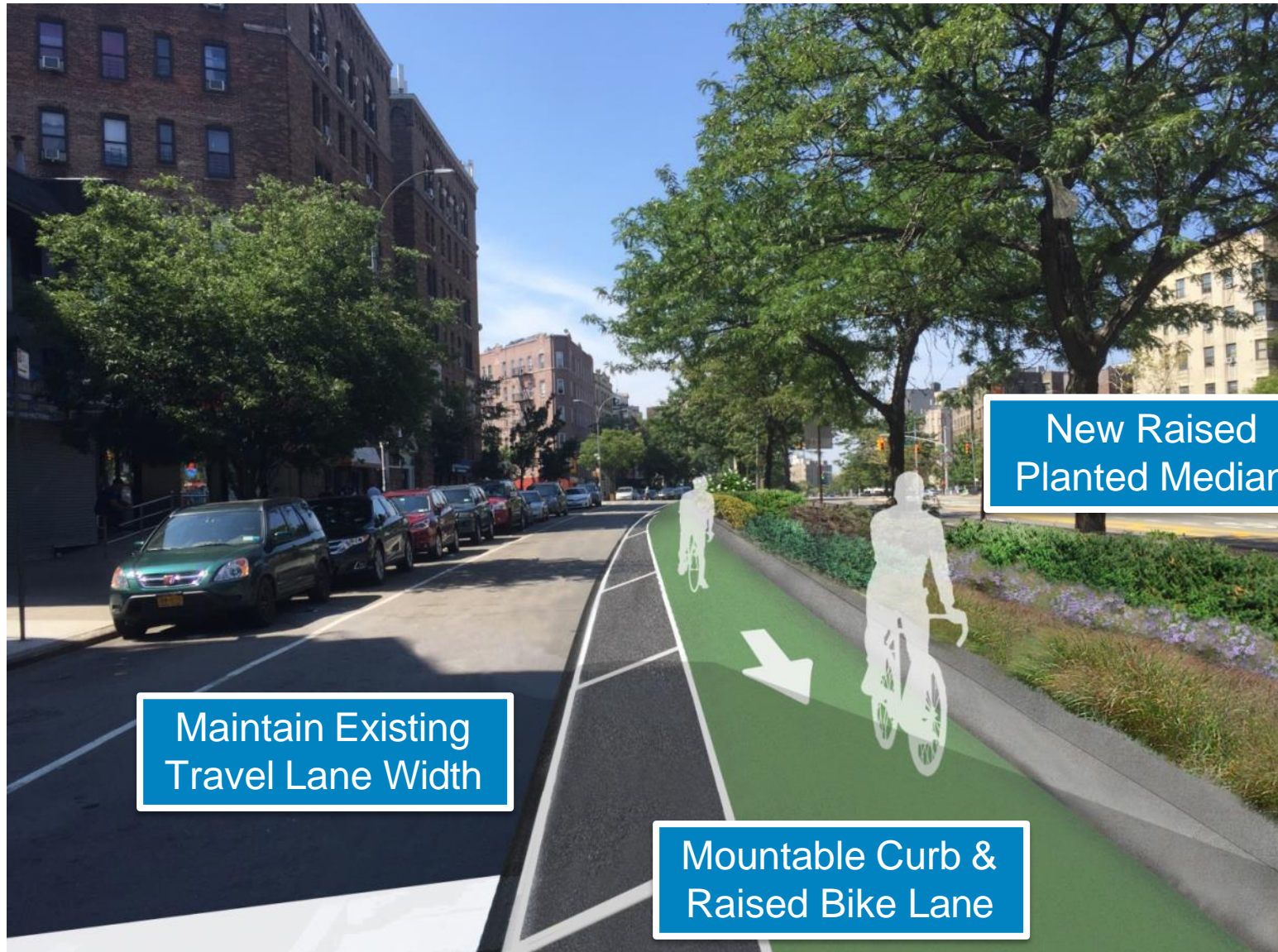

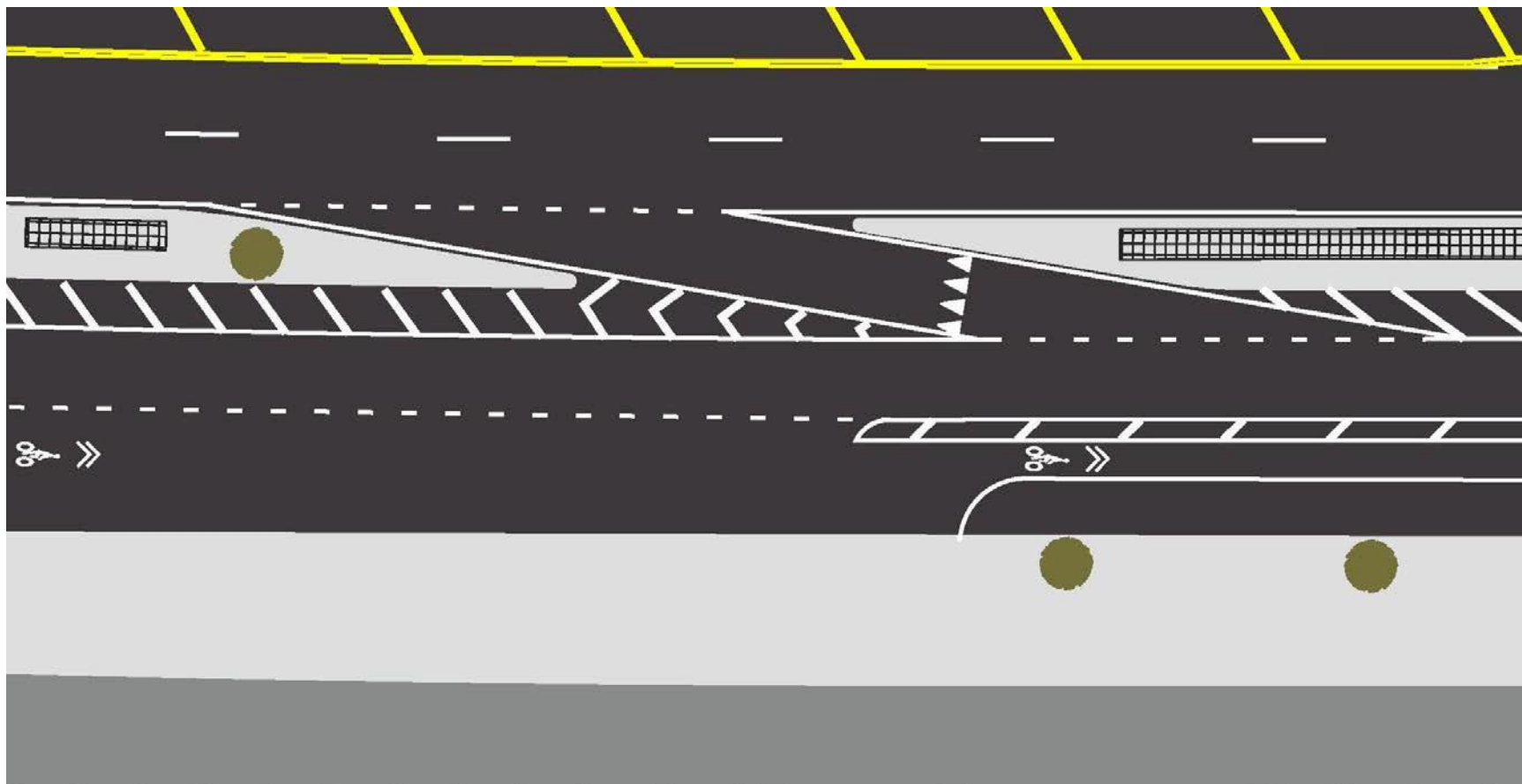

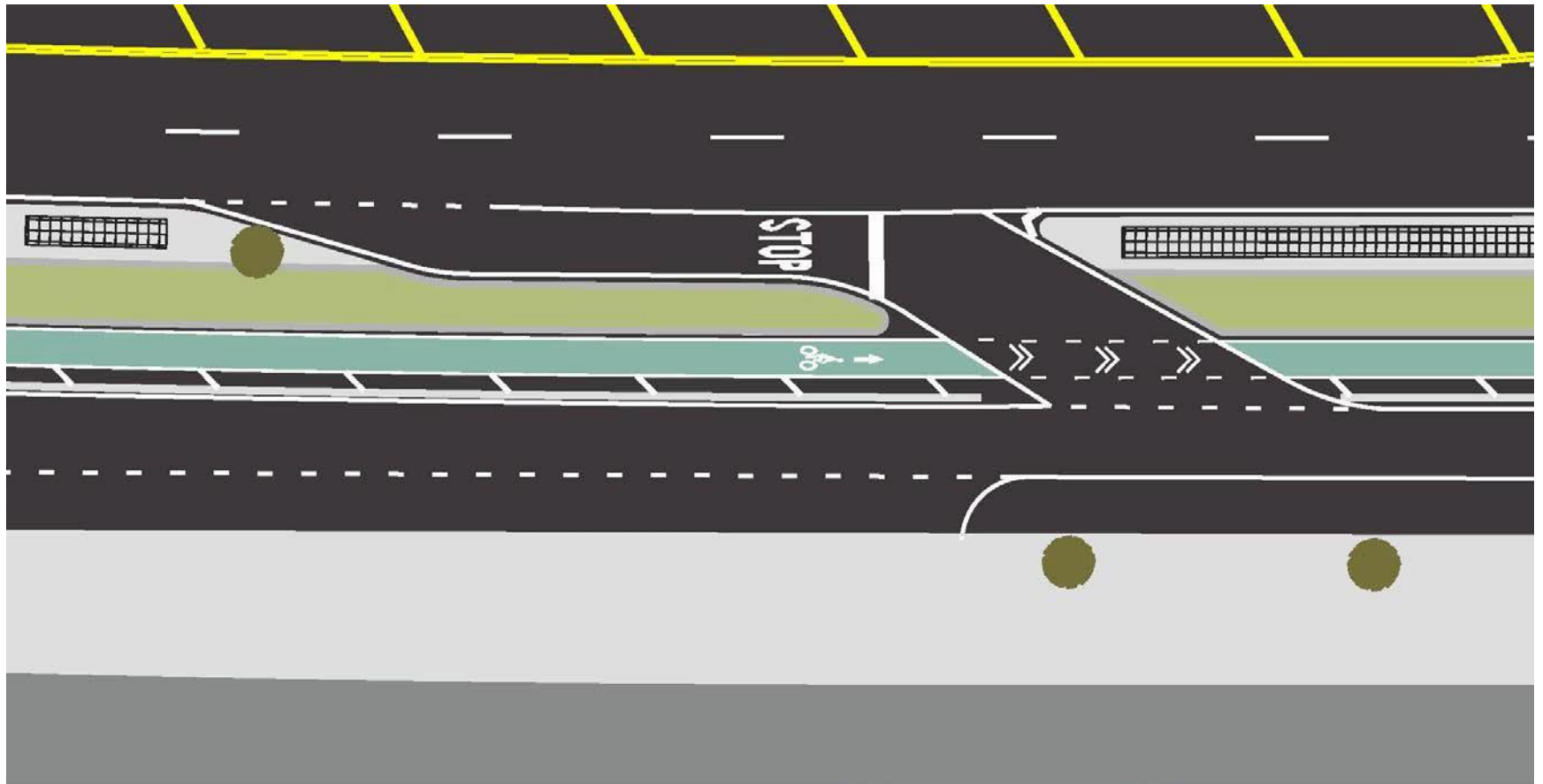
FINISHED MEDIAN
