

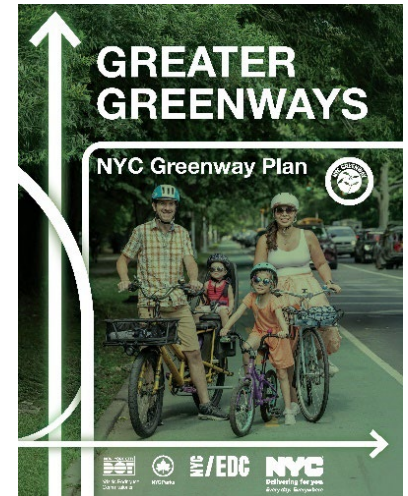

2026 Development Report

2025 NYC Greenway Plan

In 2025, the New York City Department of Transportation (NYC DOT), the New York City Department of Parks and Recreation (NYC Parks), and the New York City Economic Development Corporation (NYCEDC) released the [Greater Greenways](#) plan, the first citywide greenway plan in over 30 years. The plan inventoried the existing greenway network, system names, jurisdiction, and planned projects. This plan also presents a vision for future greenway development, with a dedicated focus on closing the gaps in the current network and extending greenway access to communities across the City. The plan was developed to meet the requirements of Local Law 115 of 2022.



2026 Greenway Development Report

This 2026 Development Report updates the current state of the New York City greenway network, representing a snapshot in time as of December 31st, 2025.

Greenway Projects completed in 2025

In 2025, the City completed 20 greenway projects across 5 boroughs and 11 greenway systems. Four projects were completed in the Bronx, 5 projects were completed in Brooklyn, 1 project was completed in Manhattan, 7 projects were completed in Queens, and 3 projects were completed in Staten Island. These projects included both NYC DOT in-house street improvement projects (SIPs) and long-term capital projects.

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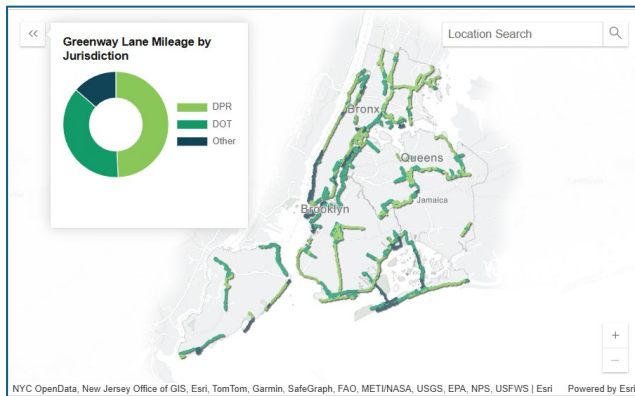
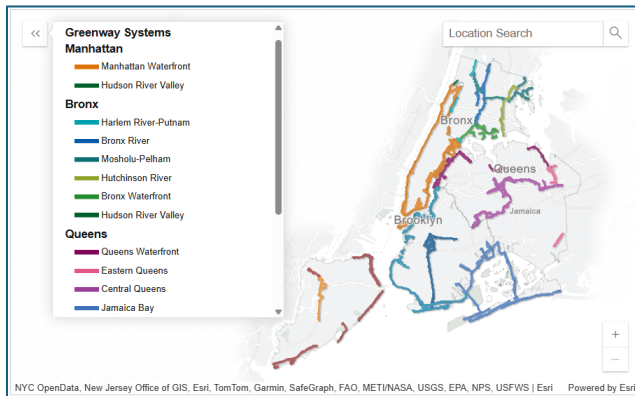
