






*Reverse one block of W 169th St between Fort Washington Ave and Haven Ave




Neighborhood area parking regulations (as of October 2017)

17 displaced alternate side spaces


Replacement spaces

CUMC/NYP Parking Strategies

- Overnight parking available to community residents at employee rate
- Overnight parking available to all CU overnight employees
 - Second Shift: 4 PM – 12:30 AM
 - Third Shift: 12 midnight – 8 AM
- Other initiatives to reduce employee vehicles
 - CU now offers no-cost shuttle service to Fort Lee, NJ for daily commuters
 - Crosstown Metro-North Shuttle Bus to 125th Street Station
 - Carpool designated parking

Deliveries and Distribution



- LOADING DOCK*
- SERVICE TUNNELS

- Central loading dock at Black Building: extend daily loading dock hours to 16 hrs/day
- Alan Rosenfeld Building Loading Dock at Riverside Drive: extend daily loading dock hours to 8 hrs/day
- Additional loading docks located east of Broadway at the Russ Berrie, ICRC, and Lasker buildings
- Promote off-peak deliveries
- Push deliveries to perimeter of campus





