NYC Plaza Program

Program Overview

- DOT pedestrian plazas are reclaimed streets transformed into vibrant, social, public spaces for all
- Plazas enhance safety, walkability, and access to public transit while supporting community, commerce, and culture
- Plaza amenities include furniture, greenery, public art, lighting, and more
- Many plazas offer public programming, markets, and other events
- Plaza proposals accepted through proposal process open April 1 – June 30 annually

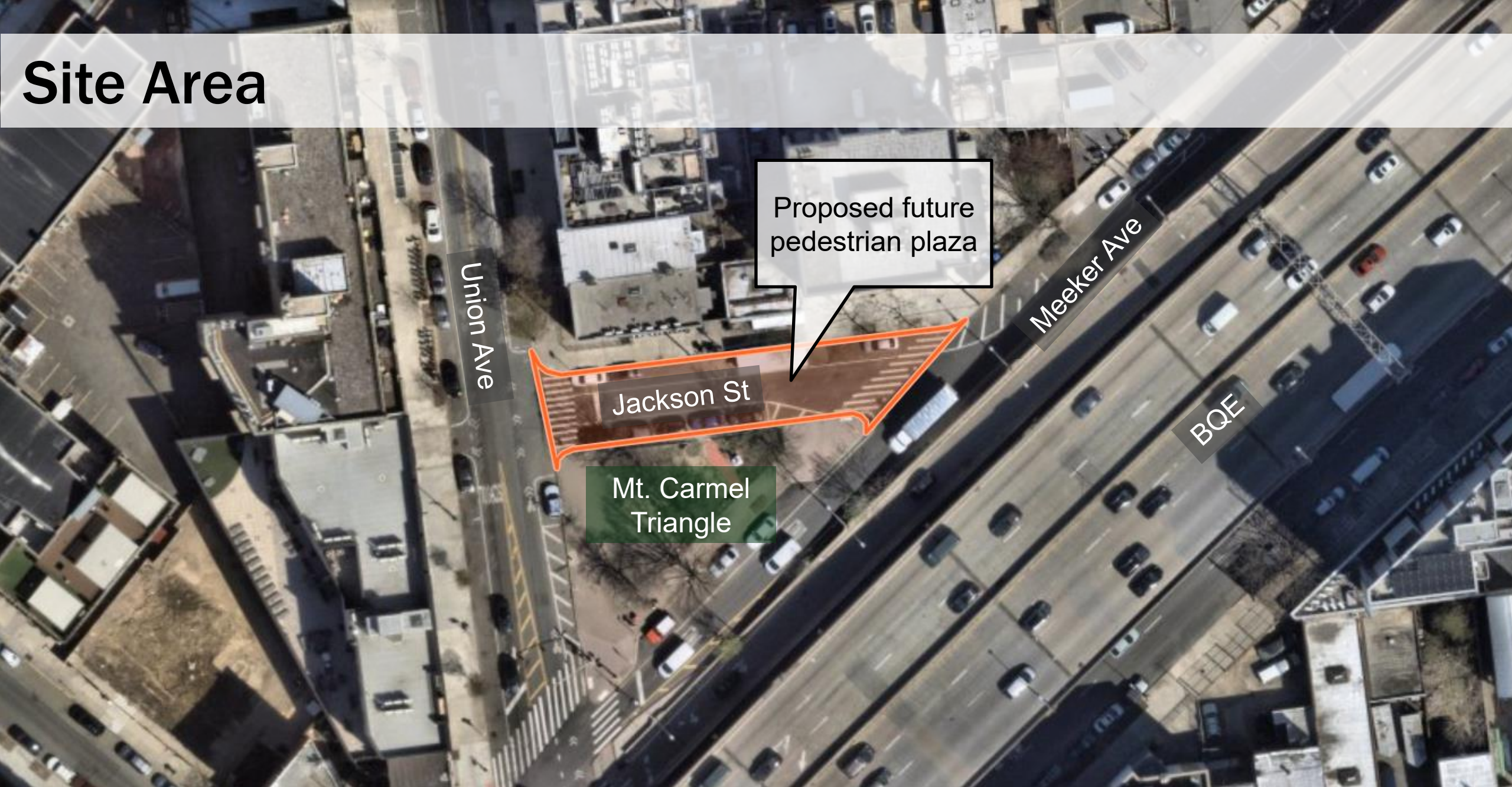
Project Overview and Proposal

Background, Outreach, and Timeline

- North Brooklyn Parks Alliance applied to NYC Plaza Program in Spring 2025, application accepted in Fall 2025
- NBPA has completed direct outreach to residents, businesses and property owners, many signing letters of support
- Pop-Up Plaza planned as first phase of project and will be 24/7, year-round pedestrian space
- Further pedestrian plaza improvements planned for this location in 2027

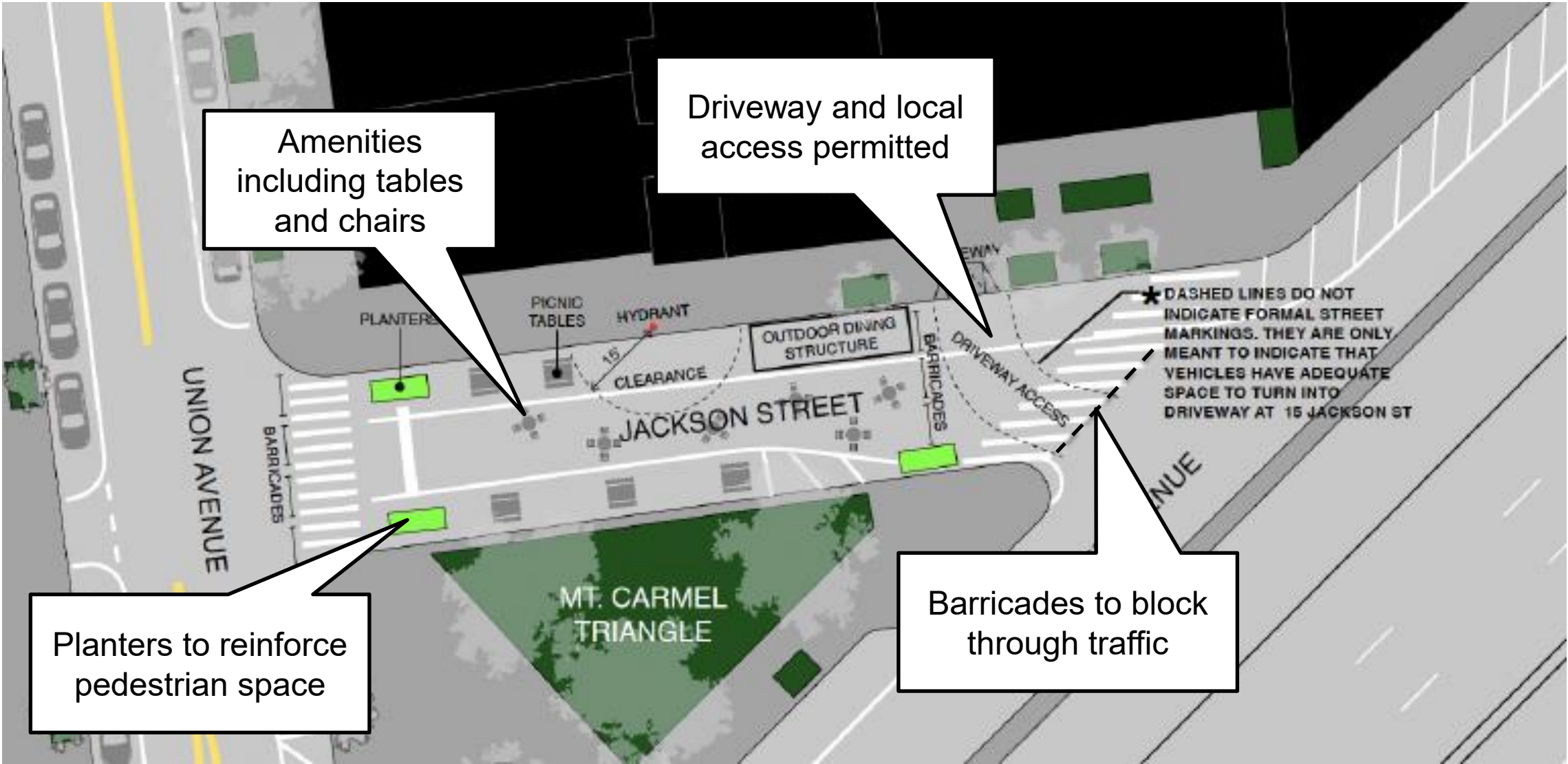

Operations and Maintenance

Maintenance and Operations Partner

- North Brooklyn Parks Alliance will be the maintenance partner and point of contact with NYC DOT.
- NBPA will perform year-round daily tasks including furniture and barrier operations as well as sweeping, litter picking, maintaining planters and other tasks as needed.

2027	2027	Interim pedestrian plaza implementation and ongoing operations
