NYC DOT will implement pedestrian safety improvements on Jamaica Ave. at the intersections of Francis Lewis Blvd. and at Hollis Ct. Blvd.:

- Install 4 concrete median tips at 2 intersections on Jamaica Ave. to provide pedestrian safety and accessibility
- Upgrade pedestrian ramps at intersections to improve accessibility
