Reduce Turning Speeds

Improve Pedestrian Safety

NYC DOT will implement street safety improvements at the intersection of Little Neck Pkwy. and Nassau Blvd.:

- Install painted curb extensions at the intersection to shorten crossing distances for pedestrians
- Install rubber speed bumps to encourage slower, safer turns onto Nassau Blvd. and into driveway entrance
- Install parking lane stripe on Nassau Blvd. to visually tighten the roadway and encourage slower, safer turns

Implementation begins July 2024
