

What's Happening Here?

Install Protected Bike Lanes

Improve Accessibility

Netherland Avenue, South Avenue to Simonson Avenue Bike Boulevard & Safety Improvements

Calm Traffic

Shorten Crossings

NYC DOT will implement a Bike Boulevard on Netherland Avenue between South Avenue and Simonson Avenue:

- Add green shared lane markings in both directions
- Construct new protected shared pedestrian and bike paths through unbuilt sections of roadway at Union Avenue and Van Name Avenue with CityBenches and bike racks
- Create Shared Street between Harbor Road and Union Avenue with advisory 5 MPH speed limit signs, and allow two-way bike travel
- No changes to traffic patterns

Implementation begins August 2021
