




Background and Past Work



Park Avenue Background

- Community requests to close slip lanes at Park Ave/Tillary St/Navy St
- Community request for crossings at St Edwards to Commodore Barry Park (signal recently installed)



Park Avenue In-House Project

- Closed slip lane from northbound Navy St to eastbound Park Ave in 2019
- New signal installed at Park Ave and St Edwards in 2021





Downtown BK

Downtown Revitalization Initiative (2019)

- Downtown Brooklyn was selected in round three of New York State's Downtown Revitalization Initiative (DRI)
- Local partners, elected officials, and organizations led a communitybased planning process to identify locations and projects to spend \$10M from the DRI grant



\$2M	Upgrade Commodore Barry Park with Better Access and Modern Play Spaces		
\$1.3M	Transform Walt Whitman Library into a Modern Community Hub		
\$850K	Create a More Accessible Public Entrance to the Brooklyn Navy Yard		
\$600K	Create a Public Art and Placemaking Fund		
\$200K	Create a Digital Tech Center at Ingersoll Community Center

- \$500K from former Boro President Adams

Park Avenue – Navy Street

Improvements


- 1. Close western slip lane
- 2. Close eastern slip lane
- 3. Add bus bulb for B62 bus stop
- 4. Reconstruct degraded sidewalks
- 5. Build out two-way bike lane as grade separated



Park Avenue – St Edwards


Improvements

- 1. Add all crosswalks
- 2. Create walkable pedestrian area under BQE with pedestrian scale lighting
- 3. Add curb extensions to shorten crossings
- 4. Relocate parking to existing turn-around area



Benefits

- Eliminates high speed turn conflicts between turning vehicles and pedestrians
- Increased pedestrian space
- Improved crossings to Commodore Barry Park
- Improved bicycle access and safety
