NYC DOT will implement bicycle and pedestrian safety improvements on Powell Street, Sackman Street, and Hegeman Avenue:

- Install a two-way parking protected bike lane on the west curb of Powell Street
- Install painted pedestrian refuge islands at intersections on Powell Street between Sutter Avenue and Livonia Avenue
- Install a pair of one-way bike lanes on Powell Street and Hegeman Avenue between Livonia Avenue and Hegeman Avenue
- Install a two-way protected bike lane on the south curb of Hegeman Avenue from Powell Street to the entrance of the Brownsville Recreation Center

Implementation begins September 2021
