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## Overview

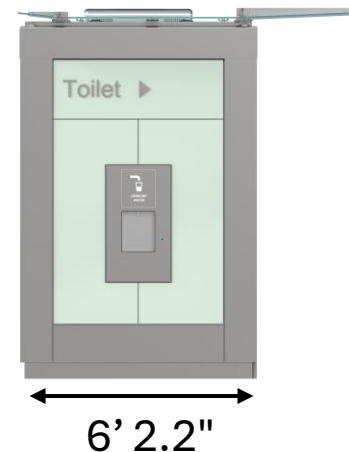
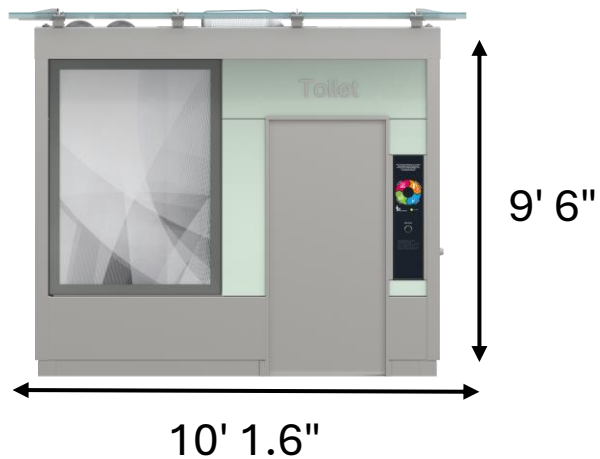
- NYC DOT is proposing installation of an Automatic Public Toilet (APT) on 12th Avenue near St Clair Pl
- Installation would occur through NYC DOT's Coordinated Street Furniture Franchise (CSFF) with JCDecaux
- Site has been evaluated for feasibility and now requires approval from:
  - Community Board
  - Councilmember
  - Public Design Commission
  - Council Speaker
  - Mayor

# DOT's Coordinated Street Furniture Franchise (CSFF) with JCDecaux

- JCDecaux
  - CSFF provides the City with bus shelters, newstands and APTs to create a unified look.
  - Sells advertising on the street furniture and provides an annual fee to the City
- APTs
  - JCDecaux installs, and maintains units twice daily
  - Open 8am-8pm daily
  - Self-cleaning
  - Up to 15 minutes per use
  - Fully accessible
  - Free of charge
  - Water bottle filler attached to side of unit

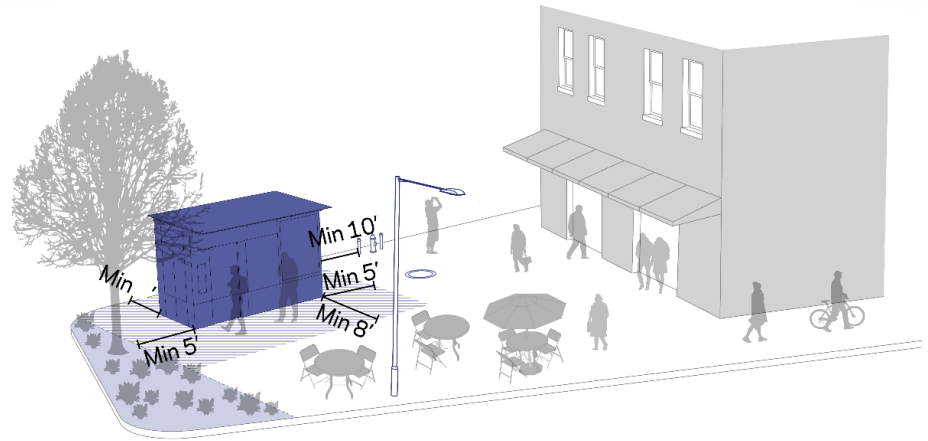
## Unit Exterior and Specs



# APT Site Specifications

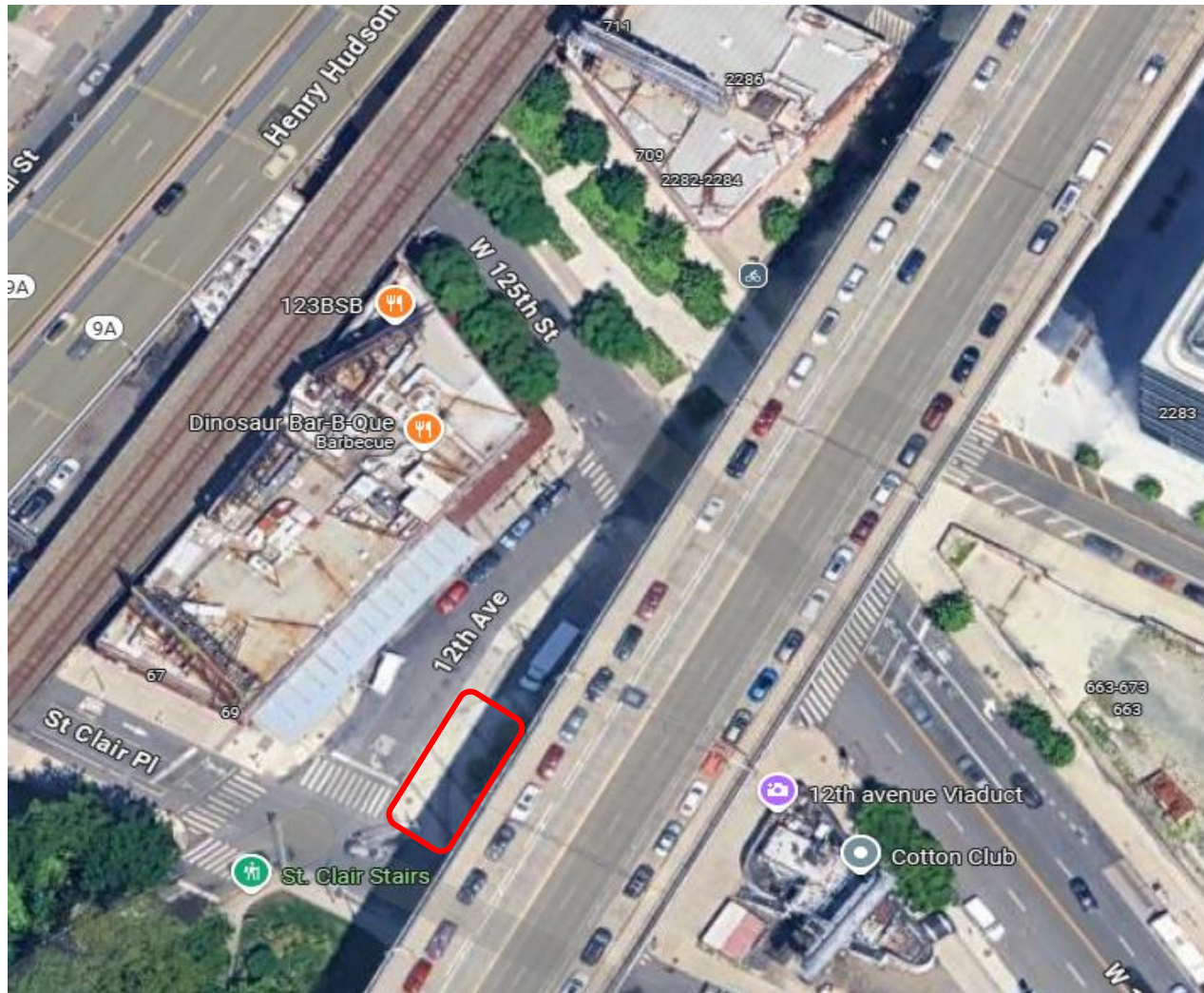
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- Street level clearances
  - 8' in the front
  - 5' on the sides
  - 3' in the back
- Underground clearance
  - 5-6' for utility and water connections.
- Features of Amended APT Model
  - New pump system will allow placement in or near flood zones
  - Footprint is smaller than a sedan size car

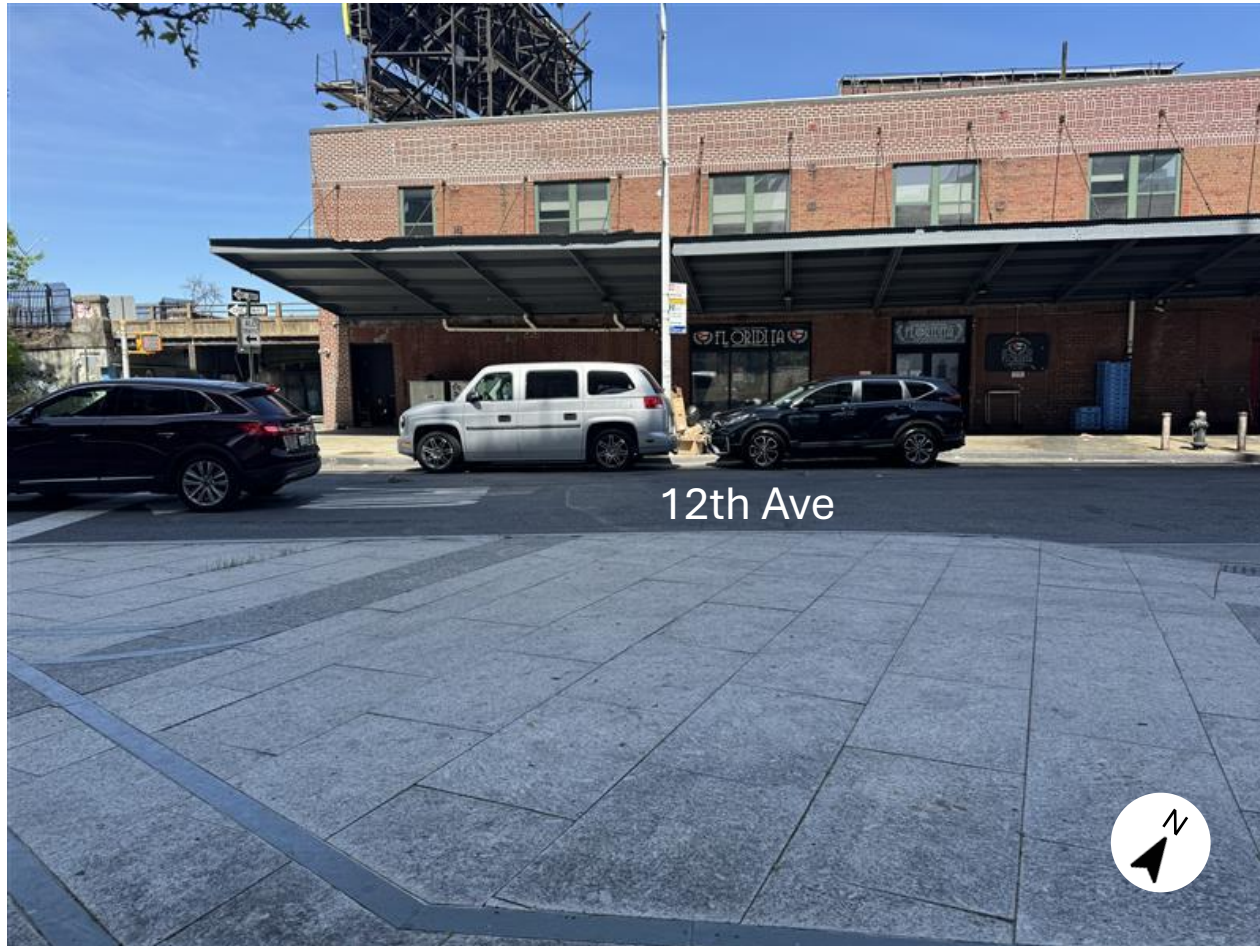
# Proposed APT Placement at 12<sup>th</sup> Avenue and St Clair Place

## History / Context

- Preference for sites adjacent to parks, Green Streets, road triangles, plazas
- Provides bathroom access near West Harlem Piers Park
- Site was infeasible with old APT model due to flood zone, but new model has upgraded pump technology
- Orientation considers factors such as trees, existing markers, site-lines, pedestrian flow, traffic, and accessibility
- Location will serve parkgoers, residents, joggers, cyclists, students, tourists, etc.

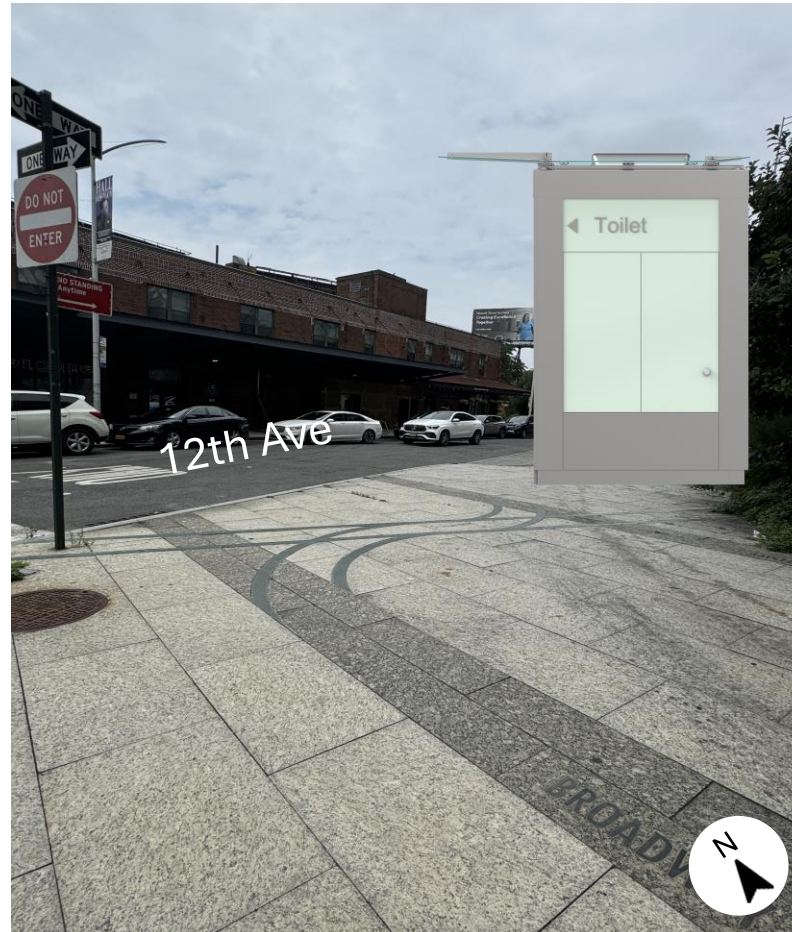

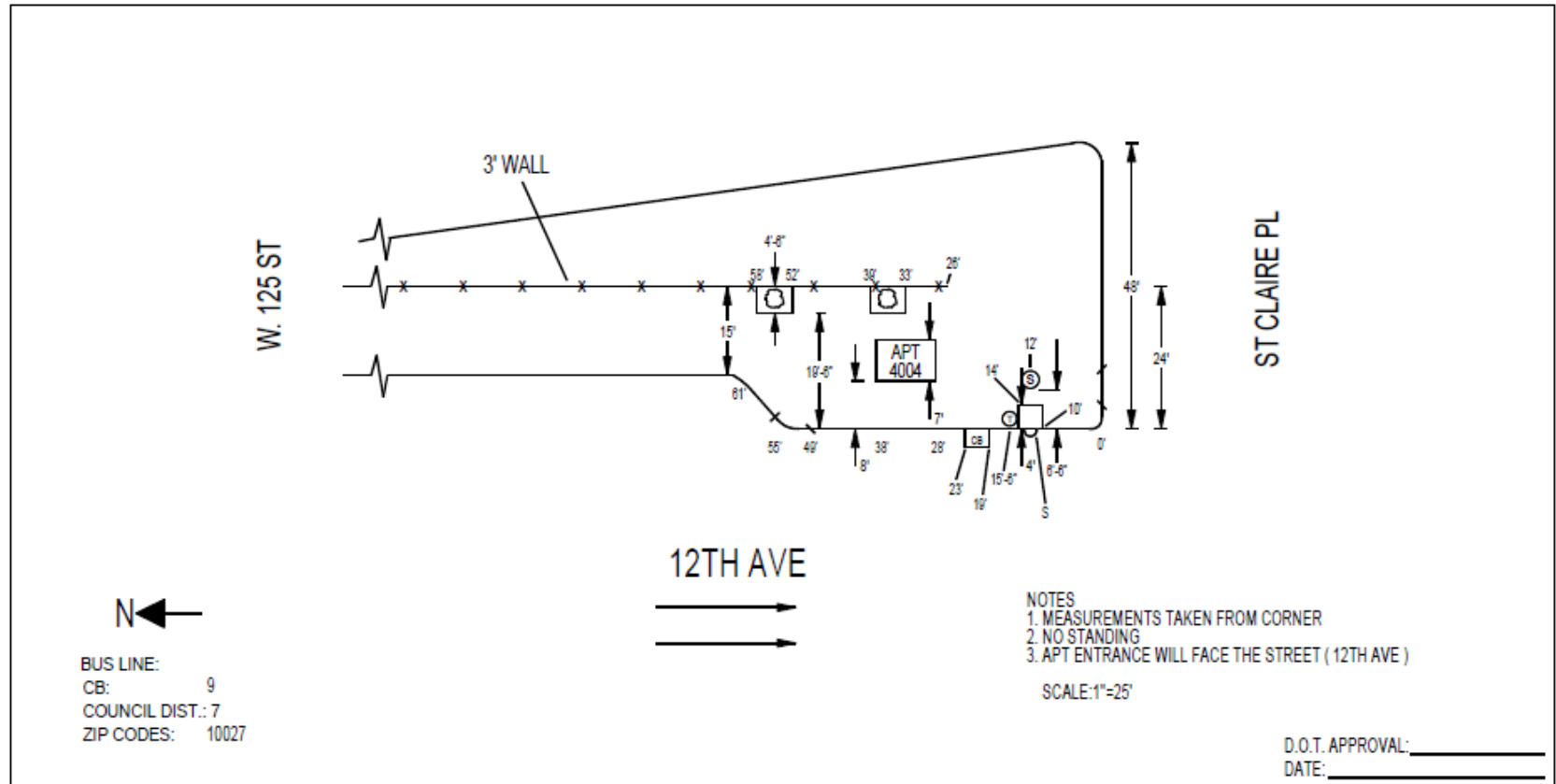
