



Recessed crosswalk limits both driver and pedestrian visibility






Soft right turn on 58th Rd allows for turns at higher speeds

Curbside lane used for unregulated parking

















Proposed Plan – Full Scope



































Existing Queens Midtown Expressway looking west from pedestrian overpass

Benefits

- Safer, shorter pedestrian crossings
- Improves pedestrian and vehicular predictability and sight lines
- Slows right turns from Queens Midtown Expressway onto 71st St and 58th Rd
- Fills gap in pedestrian network
- Improves accessibility
- Adds parking along curb
