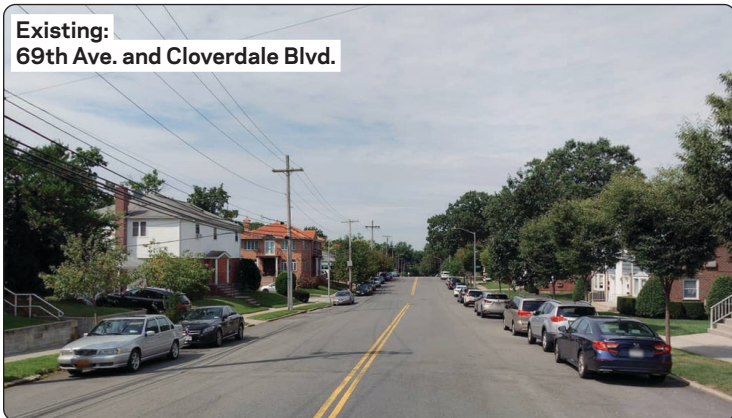
Improve Access to Parks

NYC DOT will expand the bike network in Bayside and Oakland Gardens:

- Add standard bike lanes on Springfield Blvd. from 46th Ave. to Kingsbury Ave.
- Add standard bike lanes on 56th Ave. from Oceania St. to East Hampton Blvd.
- Add standard bike lanes on 69th Ave. from Springfield Blvd. to Cloverdale Blvd.
- Add shared bike lanes on 46th Ave. from Oceania St. to Springfield Blvd. and eastbound shared lane from Springfield Blvd. to Cloverdale Blvd.
- Install a curbside contraflow bike lane on 46th Ave. from Cloverdale Blvd. to Springfield Blvd.
- Add pedestrian space and shorten crossing distance on 46th Ave. at both Cloverdale Blvd. and Springfield Blvd.

Implementation begins Summer 2024
