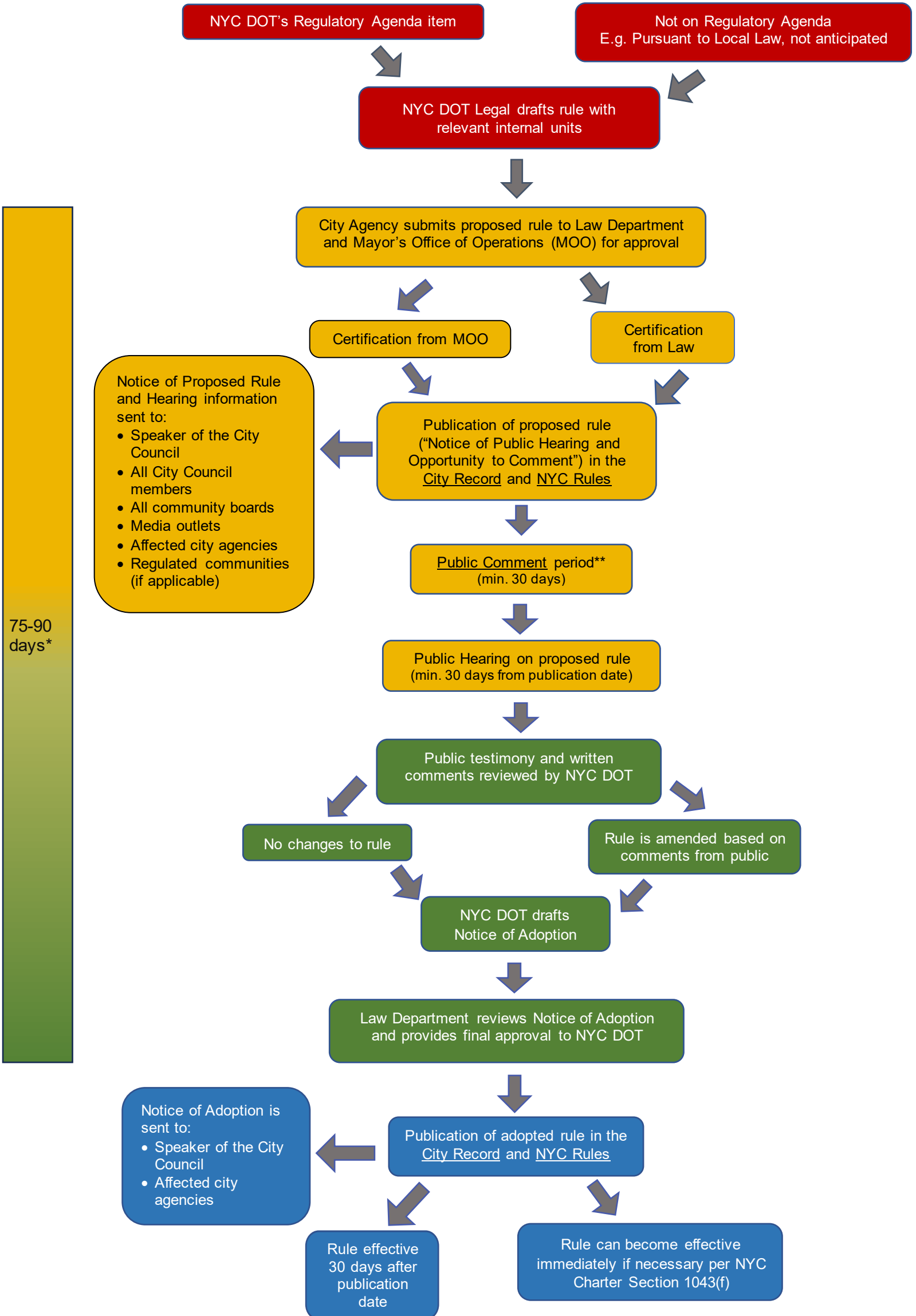


# NYC DOT Rulemaking Process and Timeline

Amend, Repeat, or Add to the Rules of the City of New York via City Administrative Procedure Act (CAPA)



Notice of Proposed Rule and Hearing information sent to:

- Speaker of the City Council
- All City Council members
- All community boards
- Media outlets
- Affected city agencies
- Regulated communities (if applicable)

75-90 days\*

\*Overall rulemaking process once the proposed rule is published takes *approximately* 75-90 days.

\*\*By law, there must be 30 days between the rule being proposed and the public hearing so the public can comment. An additional 15-30 days are generally needed for 1) NYC DOT to consider any comments and make any changes to the rule, 2) the Law Department to provide final approval, and 3) final publication to occur. An additional 30 days must pass after publication before the rule becomes effective unless the rule takes effect immediately because substantial need is demonstrated pursuant to Charter section 1043(f).
