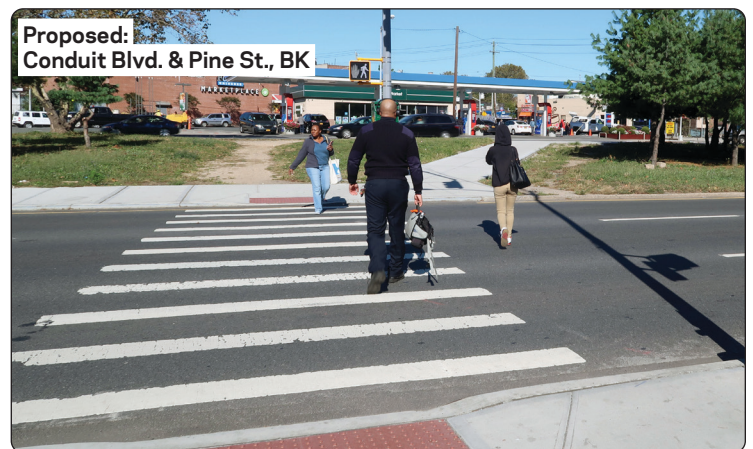
Improve Bus Service

Add Parking

NYC DOT will implement street safety and mobility improvements on Seagirt Blvd. between Beach 31st St. and Beach 20th St.:

- Install new traffic signal, crosswalk, and concrete cut-through at Fernside Pl.
- Move bus stops at Beach 31st St. (Q22) and Beach 27th St. (QM17) to signalized crosswalk at Beach 29 St. for enhanced pedestrian/bus rider safety
- Install new stop sign and crosswalk at Seagirt Ave. & Beach 25th St.
- Extend bus stop at Seagirt Blvd. & Beach 20th St. to meet current bus demand
- Remove left turn bay and add parking to Seagirt Blvd. & Crest Rd.
- Add approximately 14 spaces for residential/community parking

Implementation begins April 2024
