

Staten Island Ferry Literature Distribution Permit Frequently Asked Questions

- 1. How long does it take to process a permit application?
 - a. Permit Application processing takes three to five business days.
- 2. How are permits issued?
 - a. A select number of permits are issued daily on a *first-come, first-served* basis, and approval is not guaranteed.
- 3. What is the maximum number of people I can bring with me?
 - a. Literature Distribution Permit no more than three (3) people are allowed to distribute literature under the same permit.
- 4. Can I distribute food and clothing?
 - a. No, the distribution of food and clothing is prohibited in our terminals and on our ferryboats.
- 5. Can I distribute any kind of literature?
 - a. We do not allow the distribution of literature advertising alcohol on City property (NYC Executive Order 44).
- 6. Do you provide parking for permittees?
 - a. No, we do not provide parking for permittees.
- 7. Can I use tables or props to distribute literature?
 - a. No, tables, structures, easels, tripods, or any props are not permitted.
- 8. Can you store our belongings while we use our permit?
 - a. No, we do not provide storage for permittees.
- 9. Is there a time limit when requesting a permit?
 - a. There is no limit on your time range. However, there is a limit of five date requests per application.
- 10. Can a permit application be submitted for any day/date?
 - a. Permits will not be approved or issued for select City of New York events or holidays at the discretion of the Deputy Commissioner.
- 11. Can we distribute literature anywhere in the terminals and ferryboats?
 - a. You may request to distribute literature only in the terminals of Whitehall, St. George, or both.
