Snug Harbor to Great Kills Bike Tour (7.29 Miles)

New York/New Jersey is proud to be a host region for the 2026 FIFA World Cup™. To celebrate, NYC DOT has created a series of self-guided bike rides through some of the city’s most culturally vibrant neighborhoods.

This 7.29-mile self-guided ride begins at the Verrazzano-Narrows Bridge—the iconic suspension span connecting Staten Island to Brooklyn across the New York Harbor—and ends at the **St. George Ferry Terminal**, where riders can catch the Staten Island Ferry back to Manhattan. The Staten Island Ferry is a free, 25-minute boat ride across New York Harbor that connects Manhattan to Staten Island, offering riders sweeping views of the Statue of Liberty, Ellis Island, and the lower Manhattan skyline along the way.

Riders are encouraged to visit the **Alice Austen House**, known as Clear Comfort, a National Historic Landmark in the Rosebank neighborhood. One of America’s first female photographers, Alice Austen documented life in New York City from this waterfront cottage, which is now a nationally designated site of LGBTQ+ history. The route also passes near **SIUH Community Park**, where the Staten Island FerryHawks play baseball and the **Snug Harbor Cultural Center & Botanical Garden**, an 83-acre campus on Staten Island's north shore that began as a 19th-century home for retired sailors and today serves as a thriving arts and cultural destination.
