

#### **Project Location**

- Mainly industrial land use with some commercial and some residential land use
- Safety improvements requested several times from school staff, residents, and the DOT Bronx Borough Commissioner's Office
- Spofford Ave is in Hunts Point IBZ
- Spofford Ave is not a truck route, but Tiffany St and Halleck St are
- In Tier 1 Priority Investment Area
- Overlapping existing capital project



= project limits


#### **Safety Data**

#### Injury Summary, 2018-2022 (5 Years)

Mode	Total Injuries	Severe Injuries	Fatalities	KSI
Pedestrian	11	2	0	2
Bicyclist	1	0	0	0
Motor Vehicle Occupant	25	1	0	1
Other Motorized	1	0	0	0
Total	38	3	0	3

- 36% of injuries were caused by right-angle crashes
- This segment of Spofford Ave has 6 KSI per mile



\*Map does not include total or severe injuries that occurred at midblock locations. Data is based off NYPD crash and injury data available as of January 2024.


#### **Existing Conditions - Tiffany St and Longwood Ave**

### **Existing Conditions – Coster St and Manida St**


#### **Long Crossing Distances**






#### Proposed Safety Improvements: Spofford Ave, Tiffany St, and Longwood Ave

- Install concrete median on Spofford between Longwood Ave and Tiffany St
- Install pedestrian island at south leg of Spofford Ave and Tiffany St
- Install painted median tip extension at east leg of Spofford Ave and Tiffany St
- Install painted curb extensions at Spofford Ave and Longwood Ave, & Tiffany St and Longwood Ave


These improvements will give pedestrians a safe place to wait, shorten pedestrian crossing distance, and encourage slower, safer vehicle turns.



## Proposed Safety Improvements: Manida St to Hunts Point Ave

- Install painted median tip extensions at Coster St and Manida St
- Install painted curb extension at Spofford Ave and Hunts Point Ave

These improvements will give pedestrians a safe place to wait, shorten pedestrian crossing distance, and encourage slower, safer vehicle turns.





#### **Project Benefits**

The concrete median, pedestrian island, painted curb extensions, and painted median tip extensions:

- Create safer, shorter pedestrian crossings
- Give pedestrians a safe place to wait
- Increase pedestrian visibility
- Slow vehicle turns
