



CONDITIONS FOR THE INSTALLATION OF A TEMPORARY ELECTRIC TAP IN A LAMPPOST

- 1. Your organization will bear all costs in the installation of the temporary electric tap and energy cost at location in question.
2. Your organization is responsible to make the necessary financial arrangements with Con Edison for energy cost. Please contact Con Edison Customer service at 1-800-75-CONED (1-800-752-6633) for detail.
3. Your organization is responsible for any damage caused by this tap to street lights and street lighting system. The wiring to the street light luminaire shall not be disconnected at any time.
4. For the public safety, temporary wiring shall be installed so as not to cause a tripping hazard to the public. All applicable safety code must be adhered.
5. All work must be done by a licensed New York City Electrician.
