#### **2015 COMMUNITY REQUEST SUMMARY**

- Improve streetscape
- Improve pedestrian safety
- Upgrade ADA access to current standards
- Provide pedestrian access
- Street lighting upgrades



### **ORIGINAL SCOPE**



- Community requested DOT rethink the plan to better address pedestrian safety and streetscape enhancements
- sidewalk widening would require full street reconstruction which is very costly

# **REVISED SCOPE**

- Intersection improvements provide a greater safety benefit to pedestrians
- Revised scope addresses more of the community's request
- Locations are high pedestrian volume intersections that have been raised by LaGuardia Community College, Community Board 2, and Council Member Van Bramer

# **EXISTING CONDITION I THOMSON AND VAN DAM**

- Key location for pedestrians; difficult
- Pedestrian desire lines show need for more crosswalks
- Pedestrian ramps, crosswalk markings and materials are outdated
- Existing islands are inaccessible







# **EXISTING CONDITION I THOMSON AND VAN DAM**



# **EXISTING CONDITION** I SKILLMAN AVENUE

- Slip lane closure in temporary materials
- Sidewalk and crosswalk pavers are in poor condition







# **EXISTING CONDITION** I SKILLMAN AND 29<sup>TH</sup> ST

- 29<sup>th</sup> Street was recently converted from a twoway street to a one-way street heading north
- 29<sup>th</sup> Street does not connect to Skillman at a right angle







# **EXISTING CONDITION I CORRIDOR WIDE**

- "Staples" are outdated and reduce usable sidewalk area
- "Staples" are being used as bike racks
- Pavers create pedestrian impediments on the sidewalk and in the crosswalk







# **EXISTING CONDITION** I THOMSON AND 44TH DR

- Missing crosswalk along NE side
  of Thomson Av
- Long pedestrian crossing distances
- Speeding of vehicles





Short Term Proposal



## **PROPOSAL** I THOMSON AND VAN DAM





- Add pedestrian connectivity through crosswalks, pedestrian ramps, and signals
- Late fall 2018 or early spring 2019 implementation





# **PROPOSAL** I CORRIDOR

- Investigate signal timing improvements
- Install measures preventing Thomson Ave Bridge north curb pedestrian
  access
- Mid-block intersection in front of E Building investigation regarding conditions
- Parking review on Thomson Ave south curb to provide traffic calming and protection from moving vehicles
- Investigate Thomson and Court Square East intersection
- Working with LAGCC to improve Thomson Ave alignment at Skillman through building improvements

# CAPITAL I THOMSON AND VAN DAM

- Investigate upgrading traffic patterns
- Investigate further improving pedestrian connectivity and maximizing pedestrian space
- Upgrade sidewalk materials throughout intersection







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# **CAPITAL** I SKILLMAN AVENUE

- 1. Build out slip-lane closure
- 2. Normalize intersection by building a curb extension









# **CAPITAL** I CORRIDOR WIDE







Enhance sidewalk with upgraded materials, furniture, and landscaping





Improve pedestrian safety at intersections with high visibility and, if possible, raised crosswalks Make all curb ramps ADA compliant





### **CAPITAL** I THOMSON AND 44TH DR







Install a neckdown to provide traffic calming and pedestrian visibility



Install a high visibility crosswalk on the NE side of Thomson Av
