Improve Pedestrian Safety

Upgrade Parking Regulations

NYC DOT will implement safety improvements on 61st St. and 62nd St. between 5th Ave. and 1st Ave. and on 60th St. between 1st Ave. and York Ave.:

- Install parking protected bike lane on the north side of 61st St. from Lexington Ave. to 5th Ave.
- Install delineator protected bike lane on the north side of 61st St. from 1st Ave. and Lexington Ave., and on 62nd St. from 5th Ave. to 1st Ave.
- Install quick curb protected two-way path on the south side of 60th St. from 1st Ave. to York Ave.
- Install new rush hour lanes on both corridors between 1st Ave. and 2nd Ave.
- *implementation is rush hour regulations pending*
- Install offset crossings, pedestrian islands, and turn bays at selected locations
- Add new pedestrian and bicycle access to the Ed. Koch Queensboro Br. shared path at 60th St.
- Update parking and loading regulations on both corridors to increase turnover and reduce double parking

Implementation begins in Summer 2021
